

Key ATV Registration Information

Definitions

Class I ATV – Motorized off-highway vehicle that travels on three or more inflatable tires and has a maximum width of 50 inches and a maximum dry weight of 1000 pounds.

Class II ATV – Motorized off-highway vehicle that travels on three or more inflatable tires and has a width exceeding 50 inches but not greater than 58 inches or a dry weight exceeding 1000 pounds. Timberline and Marienville ATV Trails ONLY.

OHM – Off-Highway Motorcycle, includes dual purpose (street and trail) motorcycles.

OHV – Off-Highway Vehicle. Any motor vehicle designed for or capable of cross-country travel on or immediately over land, water, sand, snow, ice, marsh, swampland, or other natural terrain.

Registration

ATV – Operator must carry a registration certificate. Vehicle must display a registration decal and expiration sticker. The registration plate is a metal plate with the expiration sticker already applied.

Liability Insurance

Liability insurance required for a snowmobile or ATV for which registration is required. Proof of insurance must be produced and displayed by the owner or operator upon request of a magistrate or law enforcement officer.
