




JOB OPPORTUNITY

USDA FOREST SERVICE Flathead National Forest Noxious Weed Control



The Flathead National Forest is seeking two motivated employees to join our noxious weed team for the summer season 2014. Work is full time **beginning June 2 and ending on September 30, 2014** (ending dates can be negotiable). Duty stations are Kalispell or Hungry Horse, but no housing is available at either location. **The positions are for GS-0404-04 with a salary of \$13.41/hour.**

Applicants should be prepared to drive trucks with trailers and UTVs on Forest roads for long periods of time, carry a backpack sprayer with herbicide (approximately 40 lbs.), safely mix herbicides, and identify noxious weeds from the Montana State noxious weeds list. Some biological control work (insects) will be conducted. Daily records of weed treatments are expected.
