Other methods of hanging food are not effective food storage techniques in Sierra Nevada wilderness areas and are prohibited.

Pack it in, pack it out. Keep Wilderness Wild!

Waste Disposal - 200 feet (50 meters; 100 steps) from water sources, camps and trails.

_____ Human waste ("cathole" 6" to 8" deep).

_____ Dish and bathing water ("Gray water")

Elevational fire closure.

Site specific fire closures (see reverse side).

Camp at least 100 feet (30 meters; 50 steps) away from water sources.

Camp at least 100 feet (30 meters; 50 steps) from any trail.

Review additional Sierra NF wilderness regulations (see reverse for list of regulations).

Review National Park and Inyo NF wilderness regulations (if entering adjacent park or forest).

Seasonal grazing restrictions.
