2014 TEMPORARY JOBS OUTREACH

The White Mountain National Forest (WMNF), an agency within the US Department of Agriculture, is providing notice that it seeks to fill approximately 10–15 temporary positions, if funding is available, during the summer 2014 field season (May thru September). This outreach allows us to identify interested individuals. Specific job announcements with links to USAJobs will occur in the near future.

Potential positions likely to be hired:

- **Trail Crew:** Performs maintenance and construction/reconstruction on foot trails and bridges that form part of the 1,200 miles of footpaths on the WMNF.
- **Backcountry Ranger:** Performs maintenance of backcountry shelters, cabins, and campsites, and makes visitor contacts promoting Leave-No-Trace principles.
- **Developed Recreation Staff:** Performs maintenance and operational support at developed recreation sites, such as campgrounds and trailheads, across the Forest.
- **Visitor Information Services:** Provide services directly to the visiting public through face-to-face contact and telephone at one of our four information centers.
- **Timber Stand Improvement Crew:** Performs brush saw/chainsaw removal of non-commercial trees, collects seedling and tree data, and marks timber for harvest.
- **Construction & Maintenance Crew:** Work as a laborer or equipment operator (CDL required) on road projects across the Forest.
- **Archaeologist:** Conducts field surveys for historical and archaeologist resources in support of ongoing projects.
- **Biological Technician:** Conducts field surveys of wildlife, birds, fisheries and eradicates invasive plants.
- **Fire Technician:** Part of a fire/fuels crew preparing burn units, prescribed fire, and part of an organized crew fighting wildland fire.

Positions will be stationed out of our administrative sites in Bartlett, Gorham, Conway, and Campton NH.

- Respond by email or telephone to an outreach contact for the job(s) you are interested in (listed below).
 - Tell us why you are interested and give us your contact information. Tell us if you are a student, veteran or have other special status in Federal hiring.
 - Ask any questions you have about the work, housing, or application process.
- Start or update your resume and application (including transcripts) in USAJOBS (www.usajobs.gov).
- We will not be hiring under Open Continuous Rosters (OCR) as we have in the past, but rather specific job announcements for the following duty stations: Bartlett, Gorham, Conway, and Campton NH.
- We will make decisions on which positions to hire based on funding in mid-February and will notify you of our decision and the opening of the application process.
- Hiring will be completed by the end of March. Work starts mid-May.
