



Forest Order No. 17-20-01
USDA Forest Service
Tahoe National Forest
Forest System Road Closure Order



Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), and to protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited in the Tahoe National Forest. This Order is effective from April 1, 2020, through April 30, 2020, or until rescinded.

1. Using any motorized vehicle on any “Seasonal Designated” road shown on the current Tahoe National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Map. 36 CFR 261.54(a).
2. Using any motorized vehicle on any “Seasonal Designated” trail shown on the current Tahoe National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Map. 36 CFR 261.55(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 USC §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
