Trail Facts:

Length: 0.75 mile one way	Feature: Ravine, Stream
Max. Elevation Change: 280 feet	USGS maps: Finger Lakes National Forest Quad
Amount of use: Moderate	Hiking level: Moderate Blaze: Blue
Average hike time: ¾ - 1 ¼ hour round trip	Use restrictions: No horses, mountain bikes, or motorized vehicles.

Trail Description:

The Ravine Trail passes through Hemlock and hardwood forests. As the trail loops around, it crosses a stream in 3 places with native rock step crossings. It is a primitive trail with a native tread and is steep in some places. The Ravine Trail connects with the Interloken Trail at Burnt Hill Road. Please practice Leave No Trace ethics, such as carry out what you carry in.

Caution: The Ravine Trail may not be suitable for cross-country skiing. There are sharp downhill pitches and limited room to maneuver.

Directions:

From the South, take State Route 14 North (Exit 52 off State Route 17) to Watkins Glen, NY. In Watkins Glen, turn right at the Fourth St intersection onto State Route 414 North. Go approximately 9 miles north, past the Hector Ranger Station of the Finger Lakes National Forest. 0.5 miles past the Ranger Station, turn right on Schuyler County Route 2. Go east 3 miles to the Ravine Trail parking, located on the south side of the road.

From the North, take State Route 414 South to Hector, NY (Exit 41 off I-90). In Hector, 0.5 miles past the Dandy Mini Mart, turn left onto County Route 2. Go 3 miles east to the Ravine Trail parking area, located on the south side of the road.


