May 7	<u>Access and Travel Management</u> Understand the various components, issues and signs used for access and travel management decisions. Time: This session will be 1 ½ hours to allow extra discussion time.
May 14	<u>Temporary Traffic Control (TTC)</u> Review of the various components, issues, protective equipment, signs and sign placement for TTC for planned and unplanned incidents. Time – 1 hour.
May 28	<u>Sign Placement on Roads</u> Review of the requirements for placement of traffic control devices on roads. Time – 1 hour.
June 11	<u>Warning Signs</u> Proper selection and installation of warning signs for hazards and obstructions on roads. Includes documentation requirements and using warrant forms. Time – 1 hour.
June 25	<u>Signage Recreation and Administrative Sites</u> Review of the various components, issues and signs used for administrative and recreation sites, including roads, visitor information and on-site signs.
