Granite Mountain Lookout

This steep, rocky climb to an unmanned fire lookout provides panoramic views west into the Little Salmon River Basin and east toward the Central Idaho Mountains. The half mile spur trail to Twin Lakes makes a great addition to this out-and-back.

Note: Be sure to stop at Grouse Campground to view the lookout through binoculars located at the boat ramp.
