Snowslide Lake Trail

Snowslide Lake is ringed by trees, granite walls, and steep slopes untouched by recent fire activity. The trail is steep and rocky as it passes through brush, aspen groves, and both dry and wet stream crossings. Looking toward Lick Creek Road, you get the feeling that the lake is perched on the edge of the earth.

Note: It is necessary to ford Lake Fork to access the trail to Snowslide Lake, so this hike is not recommended in early spring due to high water.



Access:

Distance to TH: 16 miles

Time to TH: 45 minutes

From the McCall District Office, travel east into town on Lake Street.

- After the sharp bend in the road, turn left on to Railroad Avenue.
- At the second four way stop, turn left on to Davis Avenue and drive north for 0.7 miles.
- Turn right on to Lick Creek Road.
- Drive 2 miles and keep right to stay on Lick Creek Road, then continue for 14 more miles to the trailhead on your left.

Campgrounds: Lake Fork Campground, just 6 miles south of the trailhead on Lick Creek Road, is the nearest developed campground in the area.

Typically snow free and accessible from July through mid-October.

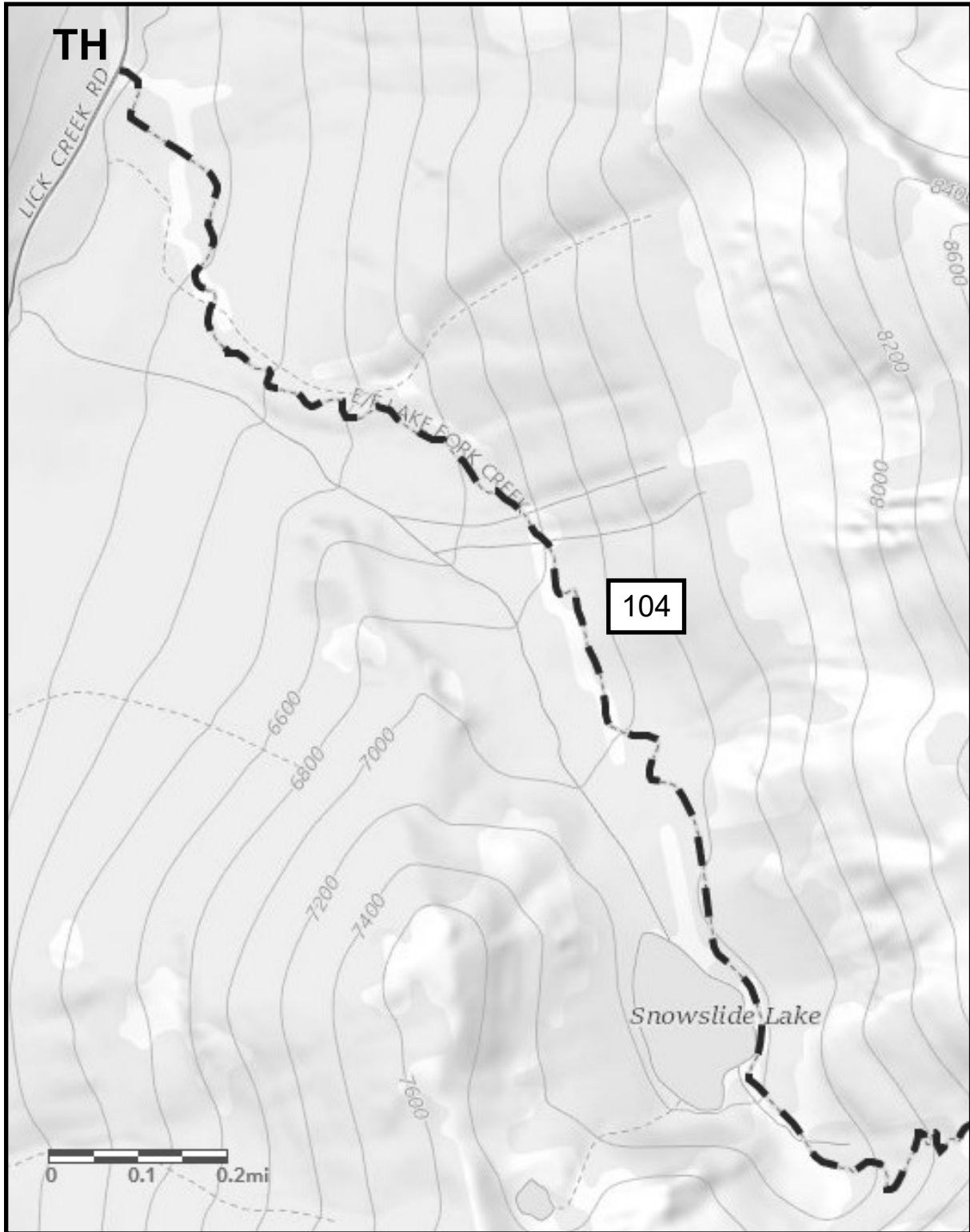
