Invasive Annual Grass/ Noxious Weeds Aerial Treatment Private Landowner Opt-In Cooperative Agreement

The East Central Idaho Native Plant Communities Restoration Working Group partners automatically build no-treatment buffers of 300 feet around private land into their treatment units. This no-treatment buffer necessarily leaves untreated invasive annual grasses and noxious weeds in a band around the private property.

Many landowners do not want this 300-foot buffer of untreated weeds around their property. They prefer to have weeds treated on state or federal land closer to their property boundary. These landowners can choose to opt-in to have the 300-foot buffer reduced or eliminated by providing information about your property on this form and signing and dating this form. We will work with you as much as possible to reduce or eliminate buffers around your private lands.
