

# Attention! Help protect your wildlife.

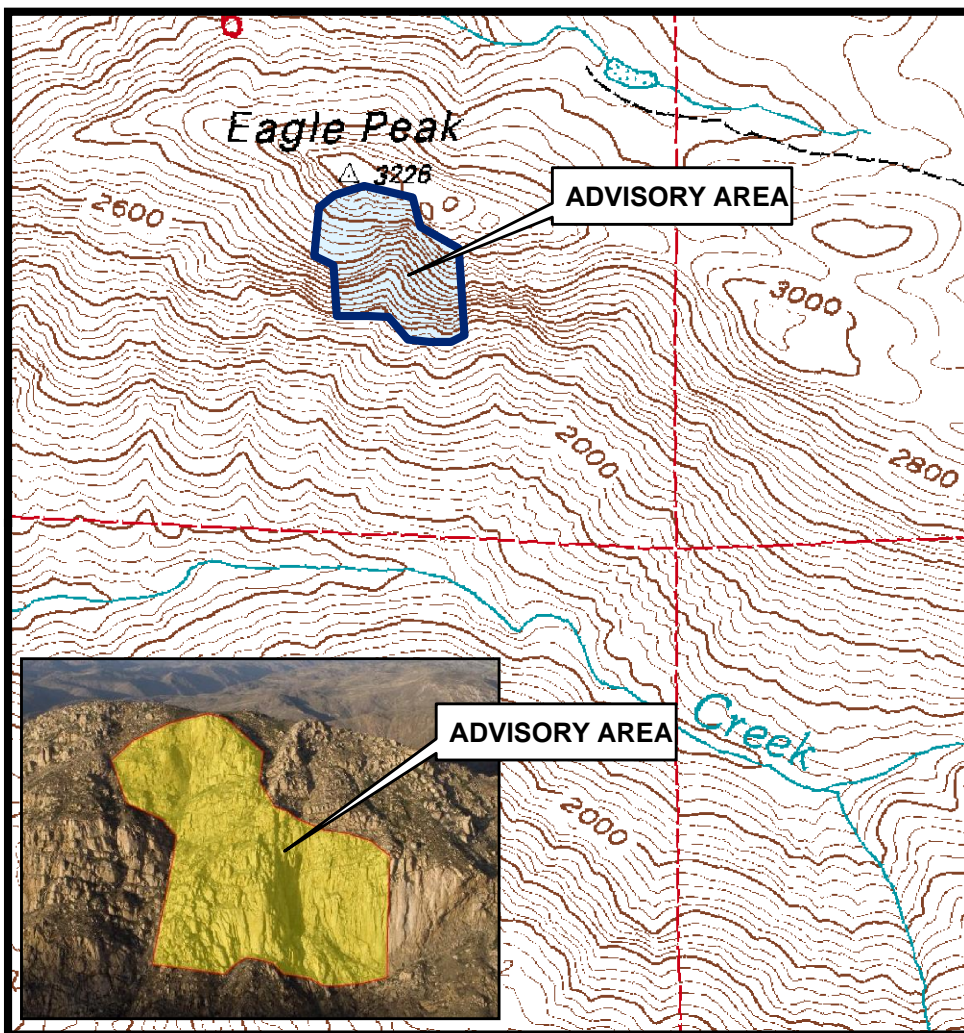
To protect nesting peregrine falcons at Eagle Peak, please avoid all activity including hiking and climbing in the area shown below, through July 31. This includes all climbing routes on the Main Wall west of Direct Route (No. 10), as found on page 29 of the San Diego Rock Climber Guide (ACSD 2009), and all summit routes (page 33, ACSD (2009)).

Cliffs provide critical breeding habitat for falcons. Human disturbance may cause falcons to abandon their nests and may result in offspring dying.
