



# Stumpy Meadows Campground

## Eldorado National Forest Georgetown Ranger District

### Location

17 miles east of Georgetown on Wentworth Springs Road.

### Reservation Information

### Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- ⇒ Swimming and Fishing. Picnic Area at Stumpy Meadows Boat Ramp.
- ⇒ Boat Ramp/Boarding Dock at Stumpy Meadows Reservoir (no water-skiing is allowed, 5 m.p.h. speed limit).
- ⇒ Dump station is located across from Stumpy Meadows campground.



### Things You Should Know

- ◆ **CAUTION:** There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored.
- ◆ Please check with the campground attendant or entrance board before setting up your camp.
- ◆ Single units are limited to 1 vehicle and 6 people per site and double units are 2 vehicle and 12 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it.
  - ◇ Vehicle=Any equipment that is required to be licensed/registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.
- ◆ Other fees: Dump = \$10.00, Pet = \$1.00
- ◆ Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
- ◆ Use the grill or fire ring provided and make sure your fire is dead out before leaving. Use only water, not soil. Use only dead and down wood for your campfires.

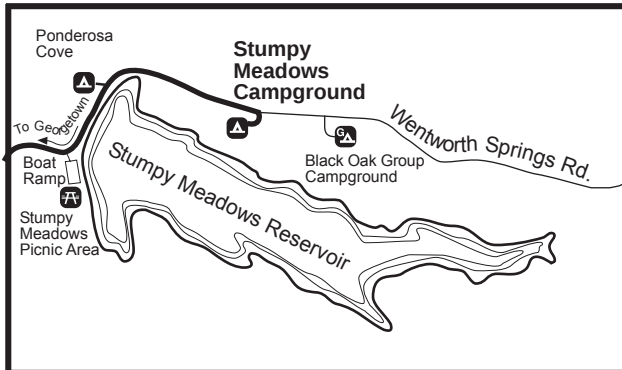

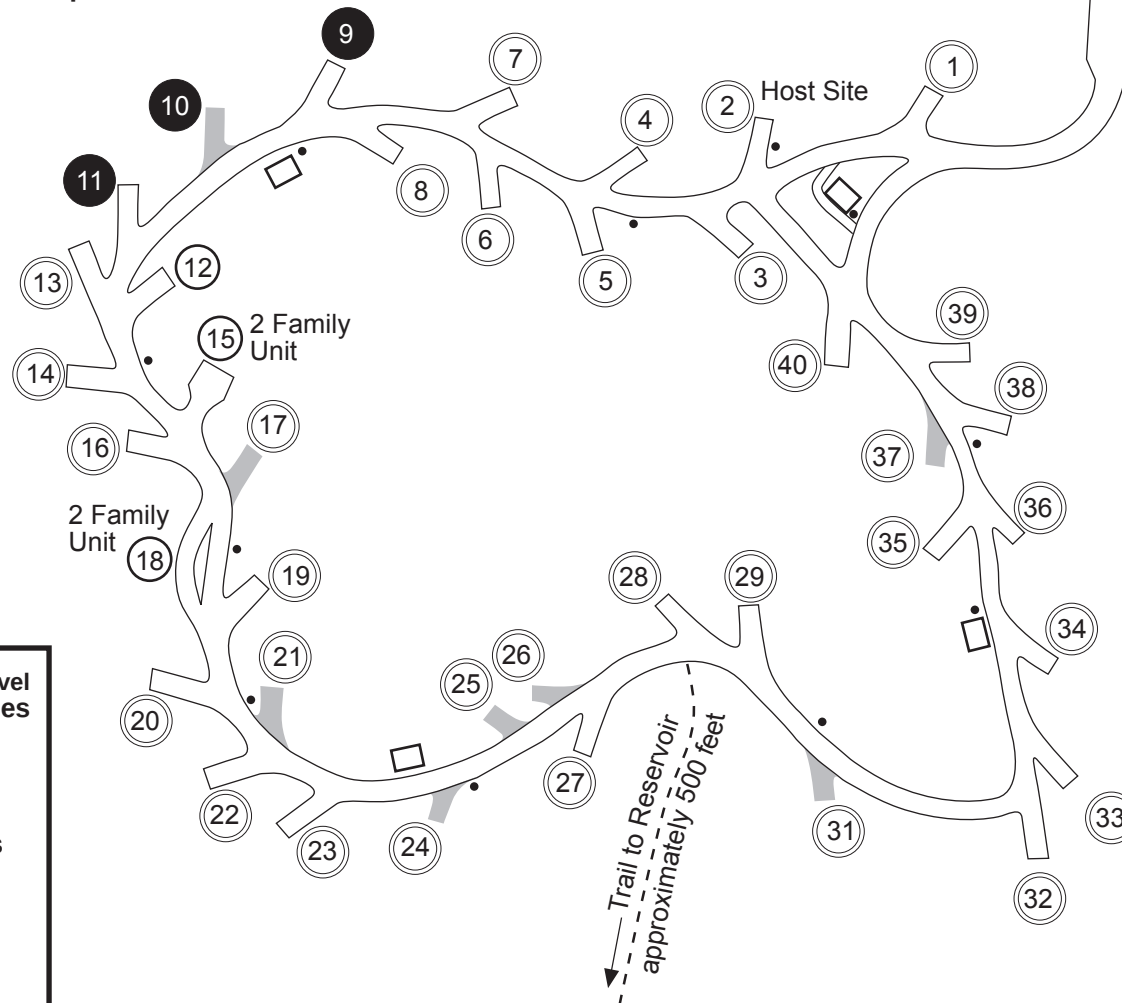


Location Map
