

Wrights Lake Equestrian Campground

Location

23 miles east of Placerville on Highway 50, 11 miles north on Ice House Road (Forest Road 3), 9 miles east on Forest Road 32 (Wrights Lake Tie Road), and 2 miles north on Forest Road 4 (Wrights Lake Rd).

Reservation Information

- CALL 1-877-444-6777 four days to 6 months in advance of your stay. Cancellations must be made 4 days prior to the start of your reservation for a refund to be considered. Refund requests must be made through Recreation.gov; No refund requests will be processed on site.

Activities/Facilities Within 5 Miles

- Swimming, fishing, hiking
- ⇒ Picnic Area (10 sites all accessible) at facility
- ⇒ Boating and dock no motors (gas or electric) allowed.
- ⇒ Hiking and horseback riding in Desolation Wilderness, permit required.

Things You Should Know

- CAUTION: There are bears in the area. Please keep all foods, soaps, and garbage properly stored in bear boxes.
- One equine or other pack animal is required per site. Campers travelling without equine or packstock will be required to leave and no refund will be granted.
- Equestrian units are limited to 2 vehicles (including horse trailers) and 6 people per site. An additional fee will be charged for an extra vehicle if the parking spur will accommodate it
 - Vehicle = Any equipment that is required to be licensed/ registered. Includes RVs, trailers, cars/trucks, boat/car trailer, motorcycle/atv, etc. Vehicles parked in a truck or on a trailer are not counted separately.



- RV filling from piped water sources in campgrounds and day use areas is NOT permitted.
- Keep family pets on a leash at all times.
