Established in 1915, the cabin program is one of the oldest public recreation programs on our national forests. In a unique public-private partnership, permittees own these little cabins in the woods for seasonal use, but the ground beneath is public land and still part of the national forests. Throughout its long and colorful history, it has provided generations of working class Americans with inspirational outdoor experiences and instilled a deep connection to the land.

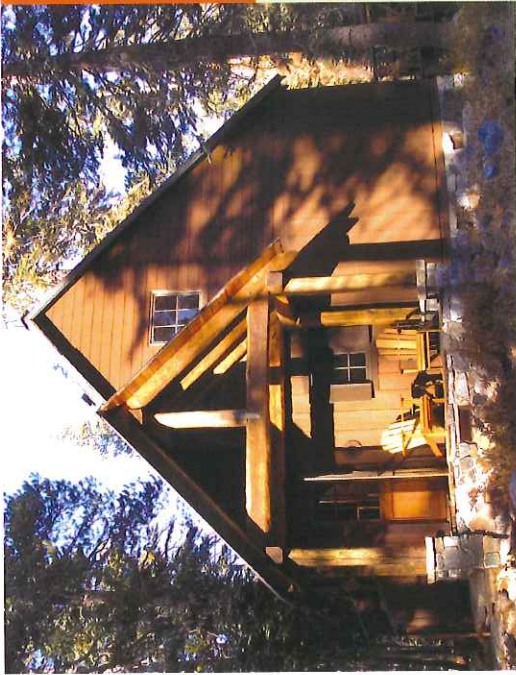
