STANISLAUS NATIONAL FOREST

Listed below are trees, shrubs and flowers that are native to the Stanislaus National Forest and that are available at local retail nursery outlets (see the attached list). It's a good idea to call ahead for availability. *The Forest Service is requesting that all plants being planted by permittees be purchased in either Tuolumne or Calaveras counties.* Our concern is the spread of the extremely harmful plant disease, sudden oak death. This disease is currently not found in either of our local counties and its spread to this area could be devastating for oak and other species found in the forest.
