CHINA HAT ROAD/WOODSIDE RANCH "INTERFACE" DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST BEND-FT. ROCK RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited in the general area of China Hat Road, near the Woodside Ranch Subdivision, from the forest boundary east to about milepost 4, as shown in Exhibit A, on the Bend-Ft. Rock Ranger District of the Deschutes National Forest, until further notice:

1. Discharging a firearm. 36 CFR 261.58(m)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or Local officer, or member of an organized search and rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
