This description and the accompanying final map are based on the Congressionally approved 17.8-miles of river segments of the main stem of the “Collawash River” and the “East Fork Collawash River” for the creation of the Collawash Wild and Scenic River contained within the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 (Public Law 111-11) dated March 30, 2009. This description and the accompanying final map shall govern all boundaries of the Wild and Scenic River and shall be considered as if contained in the original legislation, P.L. 111-11. In the case of any conflicts found between the final map and this description, the final map shall govern the resolution thereto.

Parcel “A” – Scenic Segment: “The 11.0-mile segment from the headwaters of the East Fork Collawash River to Buckeye Creek, as a scenic river.” (Public Law 111-11)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the East Fork Collawash River to and continuing from the ordinary high water lines of the Collawash River, situated in the state of Oregon, County of Marion and Clackamas, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Washington

- T. 7 S., R. 6 E.,
secs. 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 36.
- T. 7 S., R. 7 E., unsurveyed.
protraction block 46 and 47.
- T. 8 S., R. 6 E.,
secs. 1 and 12.
- T. 8 S., R. 7 E., unsurveyed.
secs. 8, 17, 20, 29, 32, and 33;
protraction block 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, and 42.
- T. 9 S., R. 7 E., unsurveyed.
secs. 3, 4, and 5.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at its intersections with the lines bearing South 57° West and North 57° East from the southeasterly most point of the headwaters of the East Fork of the Collawash River and to end at its intersections with the lines bearing North 75° 20' East and South 75° 20' West from the confluence of Buckeye Creek and the main stem of the Collawash River, said end lines shall be bounded by the same, as designated under Public Law 111-11.

ALSO, adding to said strip, a parcel of land situated in sections 32, 33, and 34 of unsurveyed T. 8 S., R. 7 E., W.M., and in sections 3, 4, and 5 of unsurveyed T. 9 S., R. 7 E., W.M., bounded by the hereinbefore described strip of land and the by the following described line:

BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of the line 1320 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of the East Fork of the Collawash River and the arc of latitude at 44°49'20.5" North. Thence from the POINT OF BEGINNING, the following nine courses:

- 1) South 0°58'30" West, 359 feet, more or less;
- 2) South 5°07'30" East, 891 feet, more or less;
- 3) South 13°18'45" East, 673 feet, more or less;
- 4) South 27°51'05" East, 307 feet, more or less;
- 5) South 31°12'50" East, 278 feet, more or less, to the intersection of the arc of longitude at 121°57'54" West and the hydrologic divide between the Clackamas River and the North Santiam River, said divide being a portion of the boundary of the Mount Hood National Forest, as designated under Executive Order 3944 as issued by Calvin Coolidge on January 21, 1924;
- 6) northeasterly, along said divide, 6040 feet, more or less, to the circle, 1320 foot radius from its origin at latitude 44°49'29.6" North and longitude 121°56'56.2" West, said intersection being located near the arc of longitude at 121°56'42.4" West;
- 7) northerly, along the arc of said circle, 1915 feet more or less, to the circle, 1320 feet radius from its origin at latitude 44°49'34.68" North and longitude 121°57'00.26" West;
- 8) northwesterly, along the arc of said circle, 1275 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet northeasterly of the thread of an unnamed tributary of the East Fork of the Collawash River, the confluence of which being located at the approximate latitude 44°49'52.6" North and longitude 121°58'14" West;
- 9) northwesterly, along said 1320 feet northeasterly line, 5825 feet, more or less, to the line 1320 feet easterly of the easterly ordinary high water line of the East Fork of the Collawash River.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM those portions of said strip lying westerly of the line 900 feet westerly of the westerly ordinary high water line of the Collawash River and of the East Fork of the Collawash River and within the bounds of the Bull of The Woods Wilderness, as designated under Public Law 98-328 and expanded under Public Law 111-11.

The area described, comprising all of Parcel "A", contains 4089 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 12.8 miles of the main stem of the Collawash River and of the East Fork of the Collawash River.

Parcel "B" – Recreational Segment: "The 6.8-mile segment from Buckeye Creek to the Clackamas River, as a recreational river." (Public Law 111-11)

A strip of land lying between and 1320 feet from each side of the ordinary high water lines of the main stem of the Collawash River, situated in the state of Oregon, County of Clackamas, and being a portion of the lands more particularly described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Oregon

T. 6 S., R. 6 E.,
secs. 21, 22, 27, 28, and 34.

T. 7 S., R. 6 E.,
secs. 3, 10, 11, 14, and 15.

The sidelines of said strip of land shall be lengthened or shortened, as necessary, so as to begin at its intersections with the lines bearing North 75° 20' East and South 75° 20' West from the confluence of Buckeye Creek and the main stem of the Collawash River and to end at its intersections with the lines bearing North 63° 02' West and South 63° 02' East from the intersection of the thread of the main stem of the Collawash River and the southerly ordinary high water line of the Clackamas River, said end lines shall be bounded by the same, as designated under Public Law 111-11.

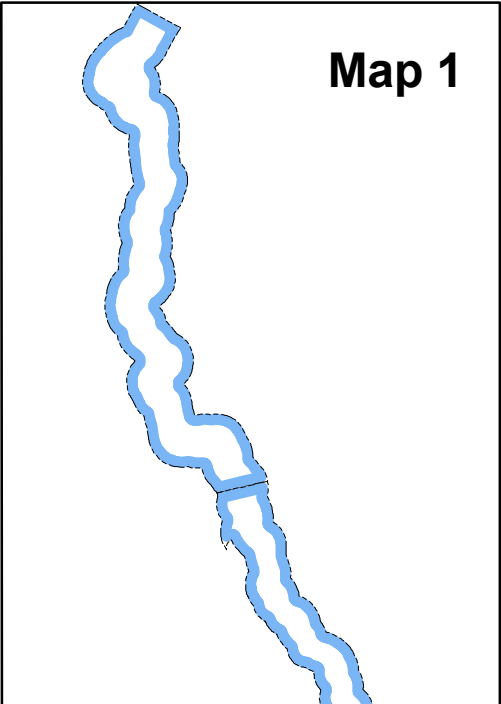
The area described, comprising all of Parcel "B", contains 2241 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 7.0 miles of the main stem of the Collawash River.

PL111-11 designated Parcel "A", the 11-mile segment from the headwaters of the East Fork Collawash River to Buckeye Creek, as a scenic river and Parcel "B", the 6.8-mile segment from Buckeye Creek to the Clackamas River as a recreational river. The most accurate mapping information now available shows that legislated river segment Parcel "A" to be 12.8 miles and Parcel "B" to be 7.0 miles. The area described, comprising all of Parcels "A" and "B", contains 6330 acres, more or less, and encompasses approximately 19.8 miles of the main stem of the Collawash River and the East Fork Collawash River.

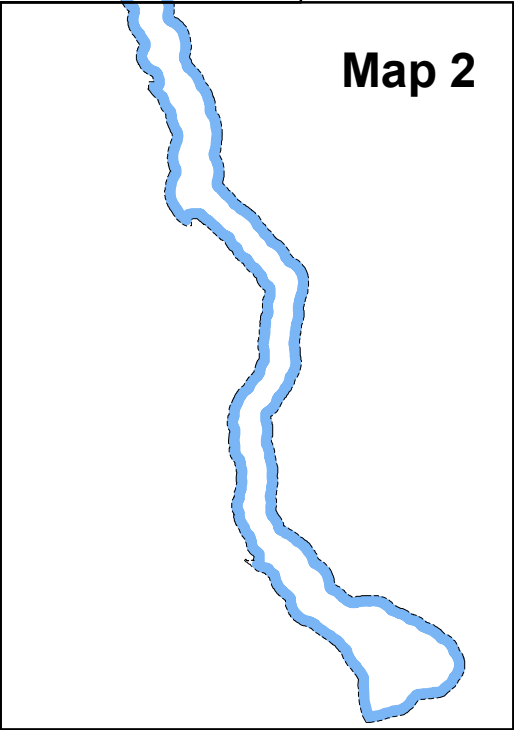
The bearings shown herein are geodetic, referenced to the true meridian, NAD 83 (2011).

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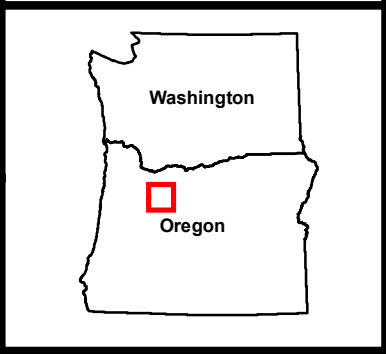

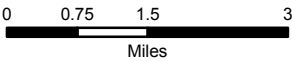

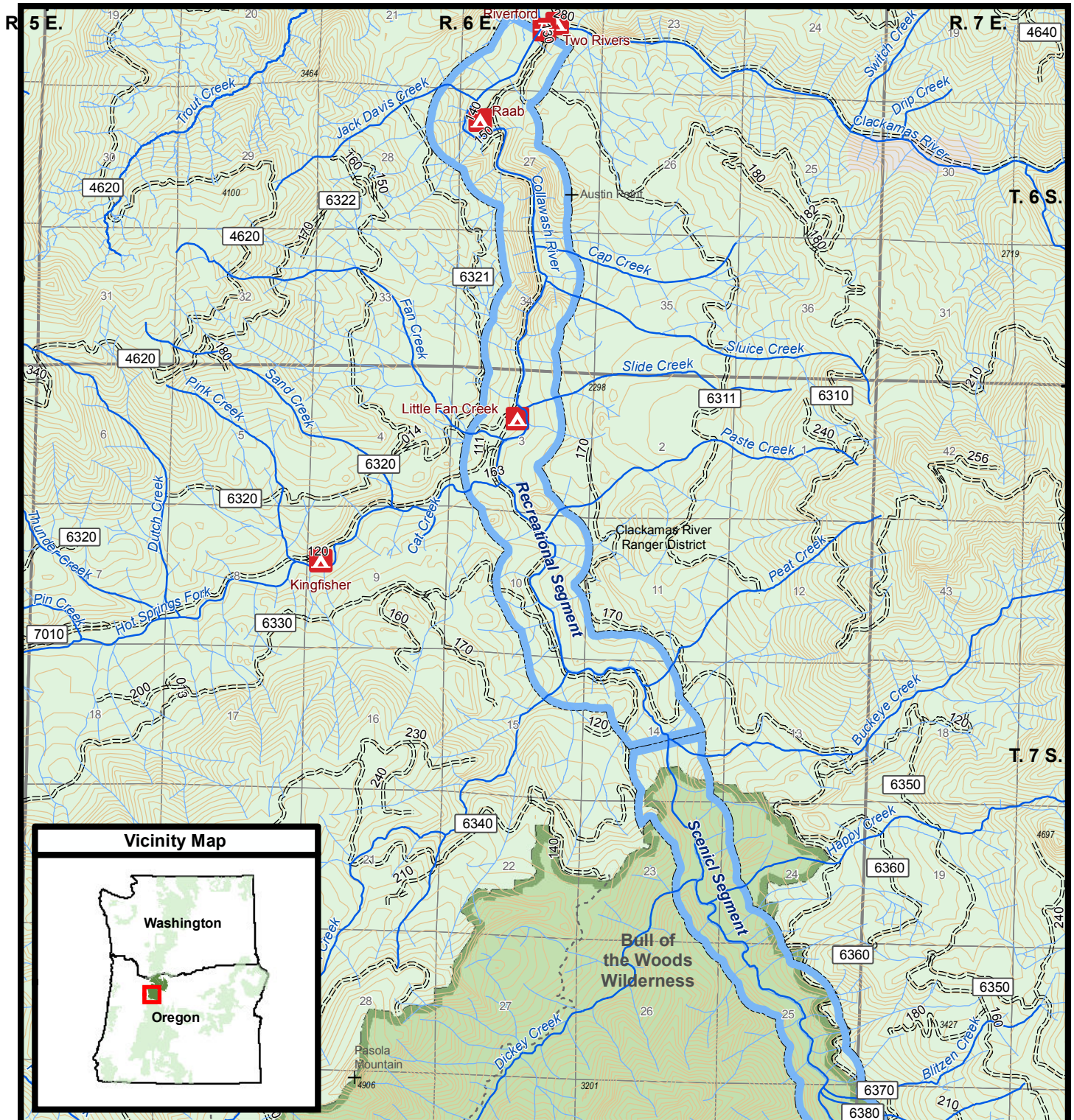

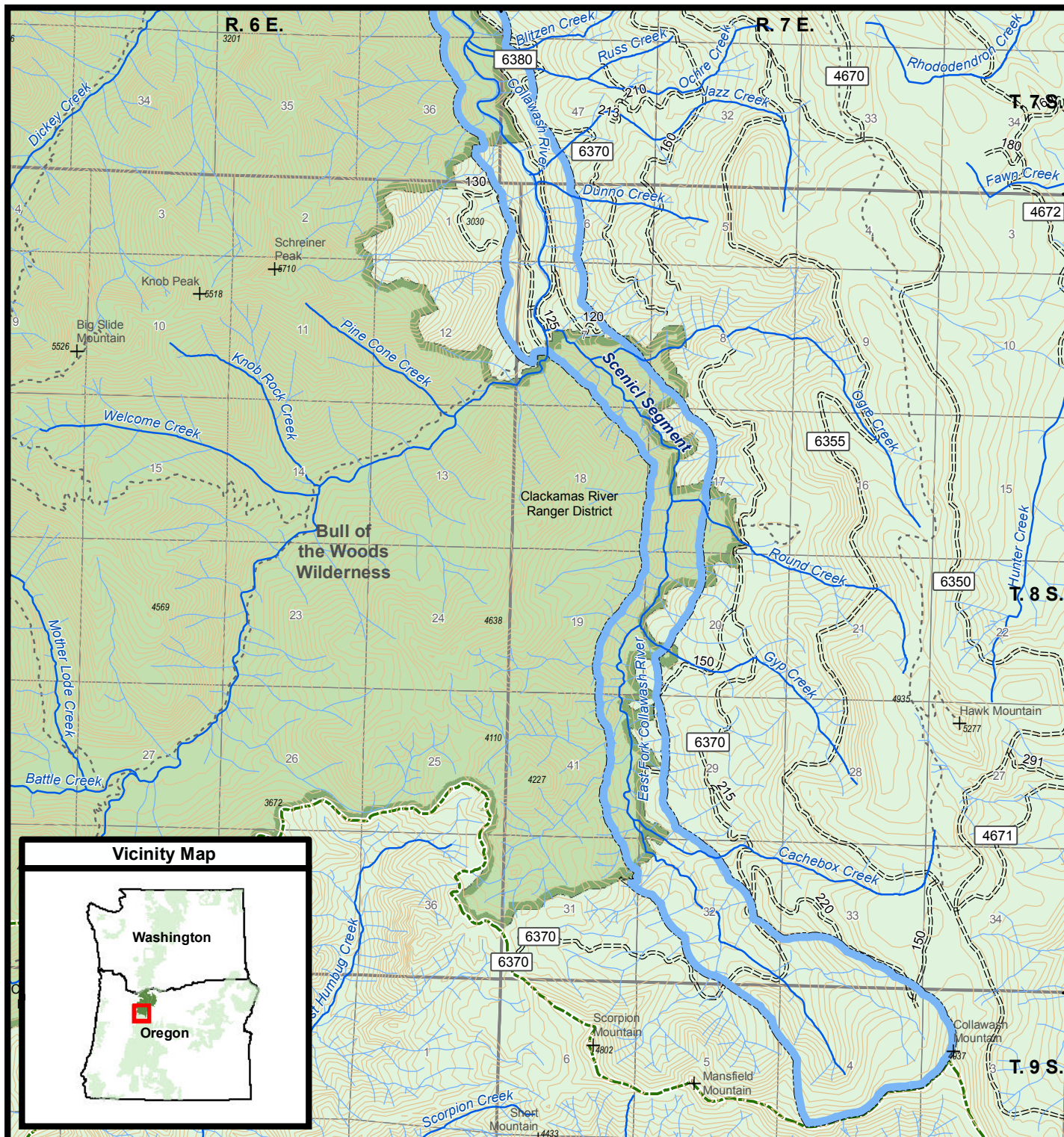
