

ORDER

SPECIAL CLOSURE

USDA Forest Service
Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) the following act is prohibited on National Forest System Lands in a portion of the area known as the Sandy River Delta and or 1,000 Acres, and as described in Exhibit A, within the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, Columbia River Gorge National Scenic. This prohibition shall be in effect until further notice.


1. Go into or be upon the area which is closed for the protection of archeological objects.
36 CFR 261.53 (c)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551, and 18 U.S.C 3559 & 3571)
