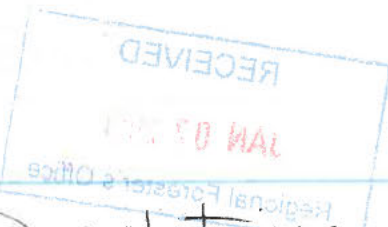
Attn: Tongass Cutting:
