 Legal Notice of Proposed Action Opportunity to Comment
 Four-Forest Restoration Initiative, Coconino and Kaibab National Forests DEIS

The Coconino and Kaibab National Forests are preparing a Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Coconino and Kaibab National Forests, Arizona, Four-Forest Restoration Initiative which proposes to mechanically treat 388,489 acres of vegetation and utilize prescribed fire on 587,923 acres. Other restoration actions include restoring springs and ephemeral channels, constructing protective fencing in select aspen stands, constructing (and decommissioning) temporary roads, reconstructing and improving roads, relocating a minimal number of road miles, and decommissioning existing roads and unauthorized routes. Restoration actions would focus on the Flagstaff district with fewer acres included on the Mogollon Rim and Red Rock districts of the Coconino National Forest. On the Kaibab National Forest, activities would occur on the Williams and Tusayan districts.

The purpose of this comment period is to provide an opportunity for the public to provide early and meaningful participation on a proposed action prior to a decision being made by the Responsible Official.

How to Comment and Timeframe
 The Environmental Protection Agency published a Notice of Availability (NOA) for the DEIS in the Federal Register on March 29, 2013. Written, facsimile, hand-delivered, oral, and electronic comments concerning this action will be accepted for 60 days following that date until May 29, 2013. The publication date of the NOA in the Federal Register is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period for a proposed action documented in a draft EIS. Those wishing to comment should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source. The office business hours for those submitting hand-delivered comments are 08:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. Oral comments must be provided at the Coconino National Forest Supervisor's (a Responsible Official) office during normal business hours via telephone at 928-527-3600 or in person, or at an official agency function (i.e. public meeting) that is designed to elicit public comments. Electronic comments must be submitted in a format such as an email message, plain text (.txt), rich text format (.rtf), and Word (.doc) to: 4fri_comments@fs.fed.us. Comments must have an identifiable name attached or verification of identity will be required. A scanned signature may serve as verification on electronic comments. Electronic comments may also be submitted online at: http://www.fs.fed.us/nepa/nepa_project_exp.php?project=34857 by clicking on the "Comment on Project" option that is listed under the "Get Connected" heading. Documents can also be attached when using this option.

Those who provide comments during this comment period are eligible to participate in administrative review. Interest expressed or comments provided on this project prior to or after the close of this comment period will not constitute standing for participating in administrative review. Comments must meet the requirements of 36 CFR 215.6. In the event this proposal becomes subject to a predecisional objection process rather than appeal, all interested and affected parties who participated during scoping or this comment opportunity will be notified of the change. Names and addresses of commentors will become part of the public record.
