**EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
RESTRICTING THE OCCUPANCY AND USE, TO WIT:
CAMP 10 FISHING PIER**

**Huron Manistee National Forests
Oscoda County, Michigan**

Under the authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended (16 USC 551), and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (CFR 261.50(a) and (b)), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the Huron Manistee National Forests located within Oscoda County, Michigan, in: Township 26N, Range 2E, Section 3. This order applies to Camp 10 Road Fishing Pier on the Mio Ranger District, Oscoda County, MI.

The said area being more particularly described and designated on the map set forth in Exhibit A, with said exhibit being attached hereto and made a part of this Closure Order.

Prohibitions: 36 CFR 261.53(e) It is prohibited to go into or be upon the Camp Ten Road Fishing Pier for the protection of public health and/ or safety.

Camp 10 Road Fishing Pier, located off Camp 10 Road in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 03, Township 26 North, Range 2 East, Michigan Principal Meridian. This site is closed due to structural deficiencies because of ice floes shifting the caissons under the pier. These structural deficiencies present a threat to public health and safety.

THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND TO PROTECT NATIONAL FOREST PROPERTY/RESOURCES. THEY ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS SET FORTH IN 36 CFR PART 261. THIS ORDER WILL TERMINATE ON December 11, 2026, OR WHEN WITHDRAWN BY A TERMINATION ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons will be exempt from the order:

1. Persons with a valid permit in their possession signed by the District Ranger, Forest Supervisor, or Forest Engineer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1); and,
2. Any Federal, State, or Local officers, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4).
3. Individuals identified as exempt in other agreements or MOU (Memorandum of Understanding).

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
