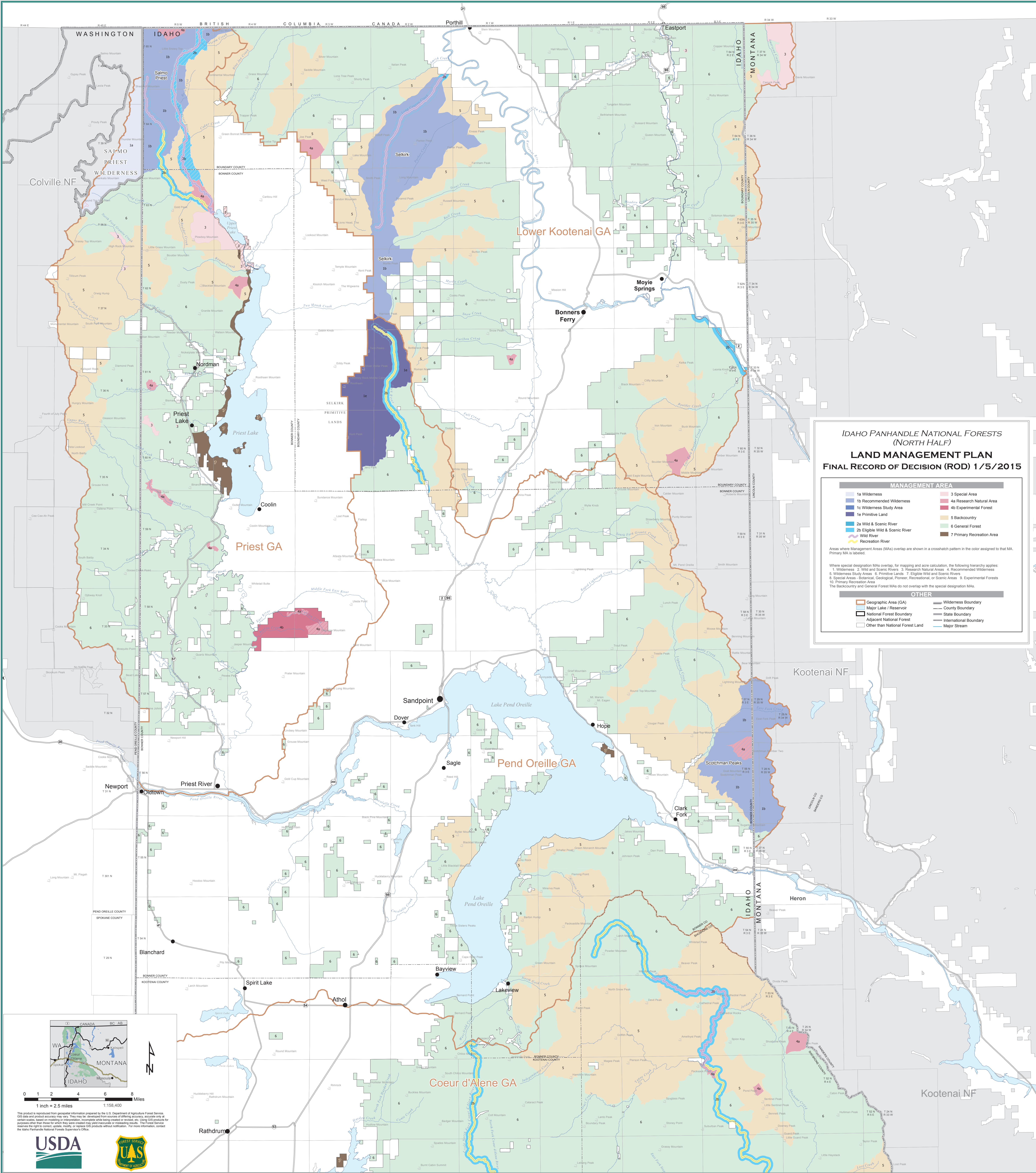

Where special designation MAs overlap, for mapping and acre calculation, the following hierarchy applies:
1. Wilderness 2. Wild and Scenic Rivers 3. Research Natural Areas 4. Recommended Wilderness
5. Wilderness Study Areas 6. Primitive Lands 7. Eligible Wild and Scenic Rivers
8. Special Areas - Ecological, Geological, Pioneer, Recreational, or Scenic Areas 9. Experimental Forests
10. Primary Recreation Area
The Backcountry and General Forest MAs do not overlap with the special designation MAs.
