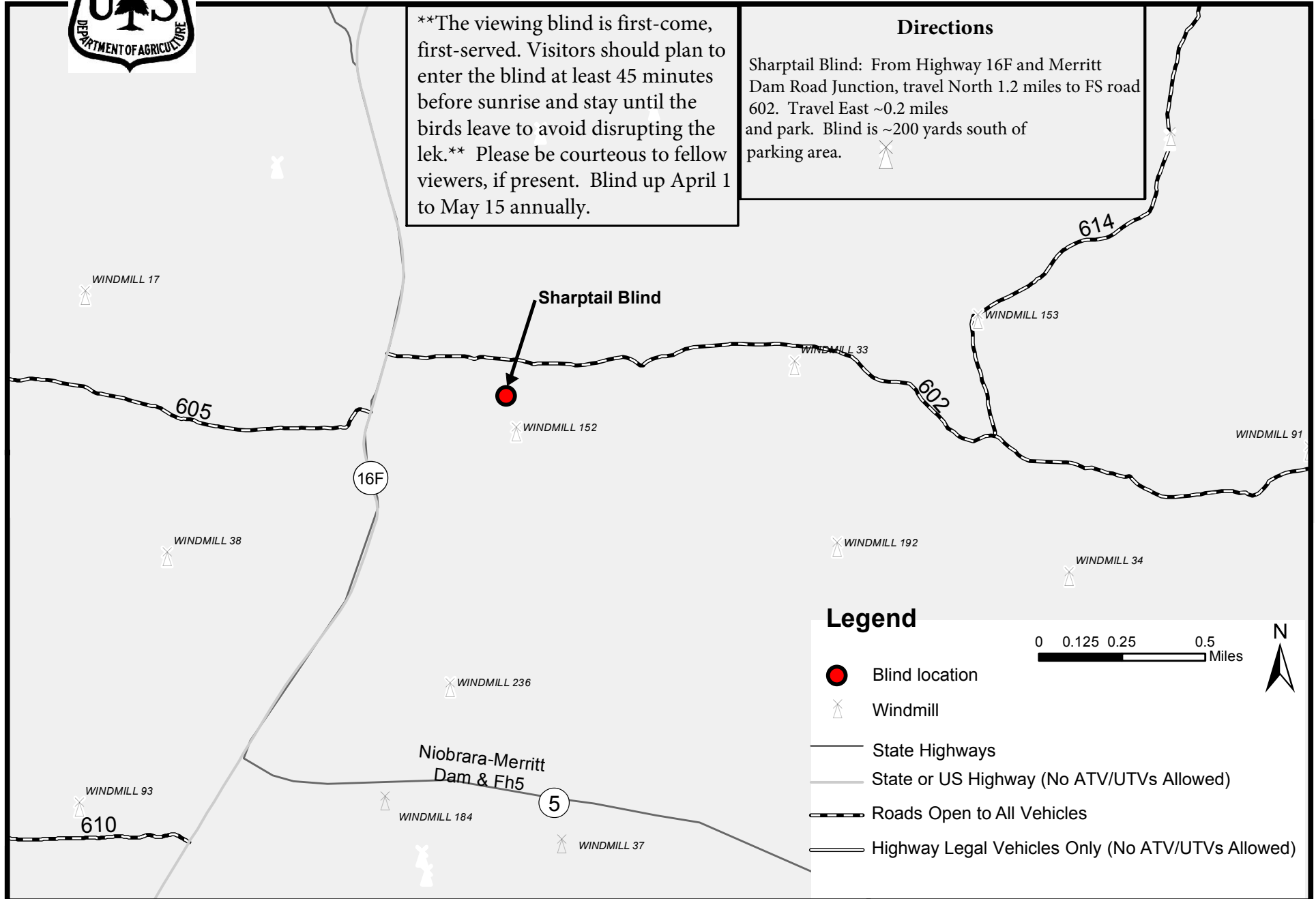
## 2025 Sharptail Grouse Viewing Blind



**\*\*The viewing blind is first-come, first-served. Visitors should plan to enter the blind at least 45 minutes before sunrise and stay until the birds leave to avoid disrupting the lek.\*\* Please be courteous to fellow viewers, if present. Blind up April 1 to May 15 annually.**

### Directions

Sharptail Blind: From Highway 16F and Merritt Dam Road Junction, travel North 1.2 miles to FS road 602. Travel East ~0.2 miles and park. Blind is ~200 yards south of parking area.
