Directions: (From Augusta) From the South Carolina line at the Savannah River bridge on Hwy. 28, travel north for 11.1 miles. Turn right onto Hwy. 23 and travel for 1.2 miles to parking lot on left.

Length: 5.5 miles one way.

Surface type: Natural, packed clay.

Safety: Avoid trail use during the first two weeks of rifle deer season. Wear blaze orange the entire hunting season. Be mindful of traffic when traveling on or crossing roads.
