Powder Pass/449 Backcountry Non-Motorized Area

The area is located approximately 30 miles west of Buffalo, WY and about 25 miles east of Ten Sleep, WY off US Highway 16 in the Bighorn National Forest.

Powder Pass/449 Backcountry Non-Motorized Area offers over 2,880 acres of non-motorized winter recreation opportunity. The elevation range is about 9,600 feet to over 10,000 feet. With spectacular 360 degree views from the summits, this is a great place to get away for a backcountry experience.

There are no groomed or marked trails in this area. This area is open to non-motorized use only; a map is available at fs.usda.gov/r02/bighorn

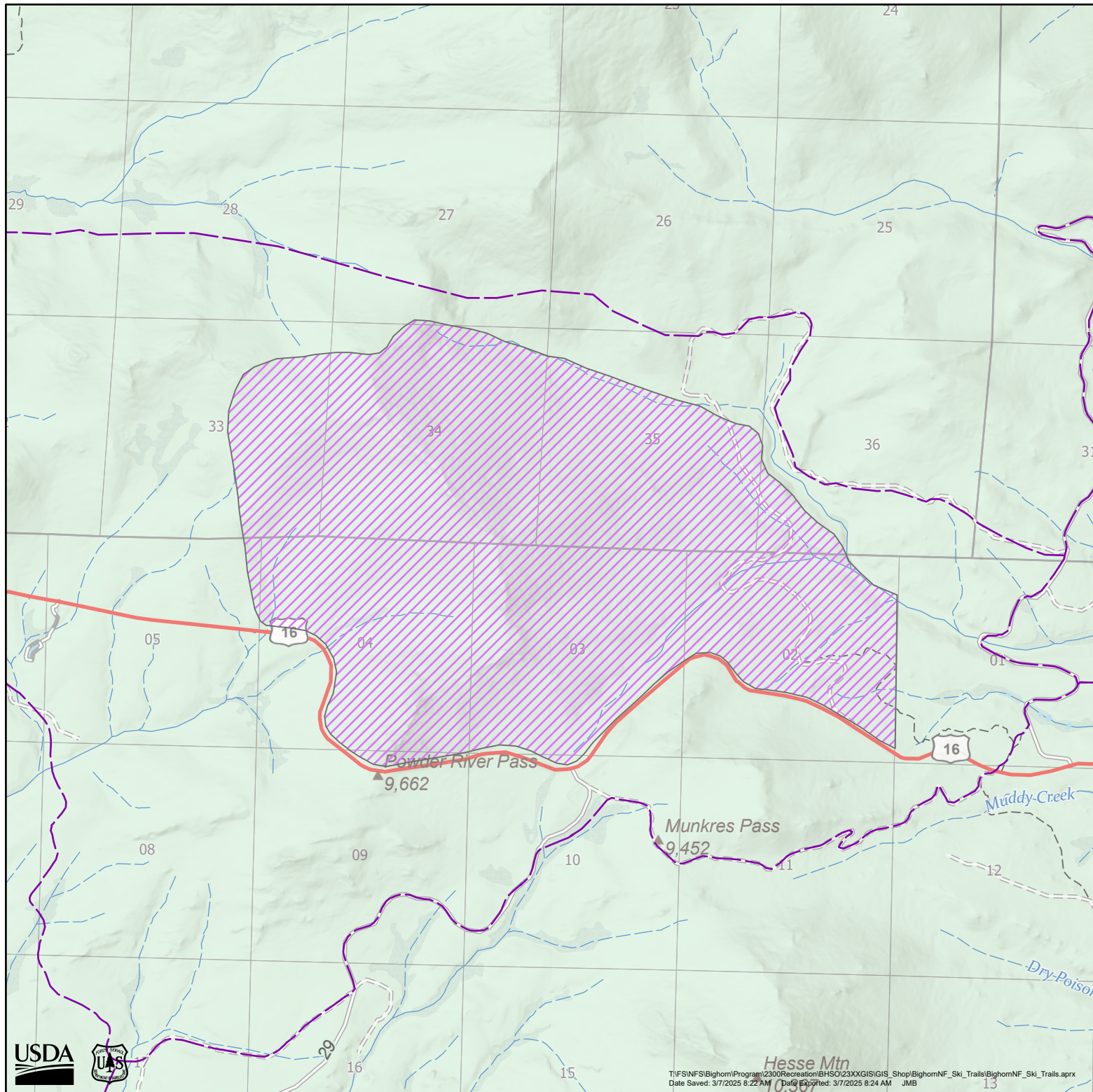
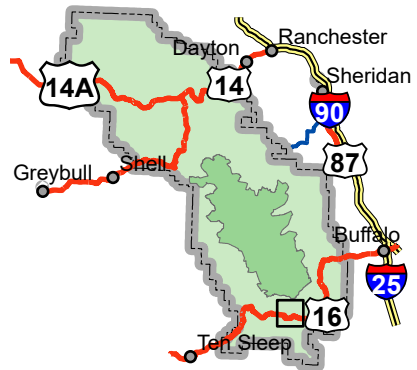
