**Motor vehicle Regulation**


Pursuant to Title 36 C.F.R, Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act or omission applying to "ATV and ORV operations" is prohibited within the Blue Ridge Ranger District, Chattahoochee National Forest. The provisions will remain in effect from June 1, 2010 through May 31, 2015.

1. For the protection of Forest Service lands and property, the use of bolted or studded tires, or tire chains on any designated trail. 36 CFR 261.53 (f)

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 36 C.F.R, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from the above prohibition:

1. Persons with a permit specially authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or firefighting force in the official performance of their duties.
