



Gifford Pinchot National Forest Free-Use Firewood Permit Application

A firewood permit and load tags are required to cut and remove firewood from National Forest lands. Under the Forest Service Free-Use Firewood Program, you are allowed a maximum of 6 cords per household each year at no cost.

Please complete the information below and mail this application to the Ranger District where you plan to cut your firewood. **Enclose a copy of your driver's license or state identification.** The addresses and phone numbers are listed below.

Your permit, load tags, cutting area maps and other information will be mailed to you within two weeks. Be sure to carefully read all the conditions stated on your permit before you begin cutting.
