Scan and Pay Information and Instructions

Introducing the [Recreation.gov](https://www.recreation.gov) mobile app's **Scan & Pay** feature. This feature allows quicker access by using your mobile device to pay directly for first-come, first-served campsites at the **Sather Lake, Buffalo Gap, and CCC Campgrounds**.

The step-by-step instructions (*also provided here*) and QR code are posted on each site's information kiosk.

Once you have utilized the Scan & Pay feature, please help us track this new feature by following these steps:

1. Find a fee envelope from the fee tube and fill it out.
2. On the fee envelope, write your Online Confirmation Number in box 10 in this format: OCN-XXXX. If applicable, add your Interagency Pass for Senior, Access, or Golden Passport #.
3. Tear off the Proof of Payment tab and place it on the campsite post you're occupying.
4. Place the envelope into the Fee Tube.

The Scan & Pay feature is available even without a cellular connection, as the app stores the payment until a connection is re-established.

The app is available on the Apple App Store for iOS devices and the Google Play Store for Android devices, or from the [Recreation.gov](https://www.recreation.gov) mobile app page <https://www.recreation.gov/mobile-app>.
