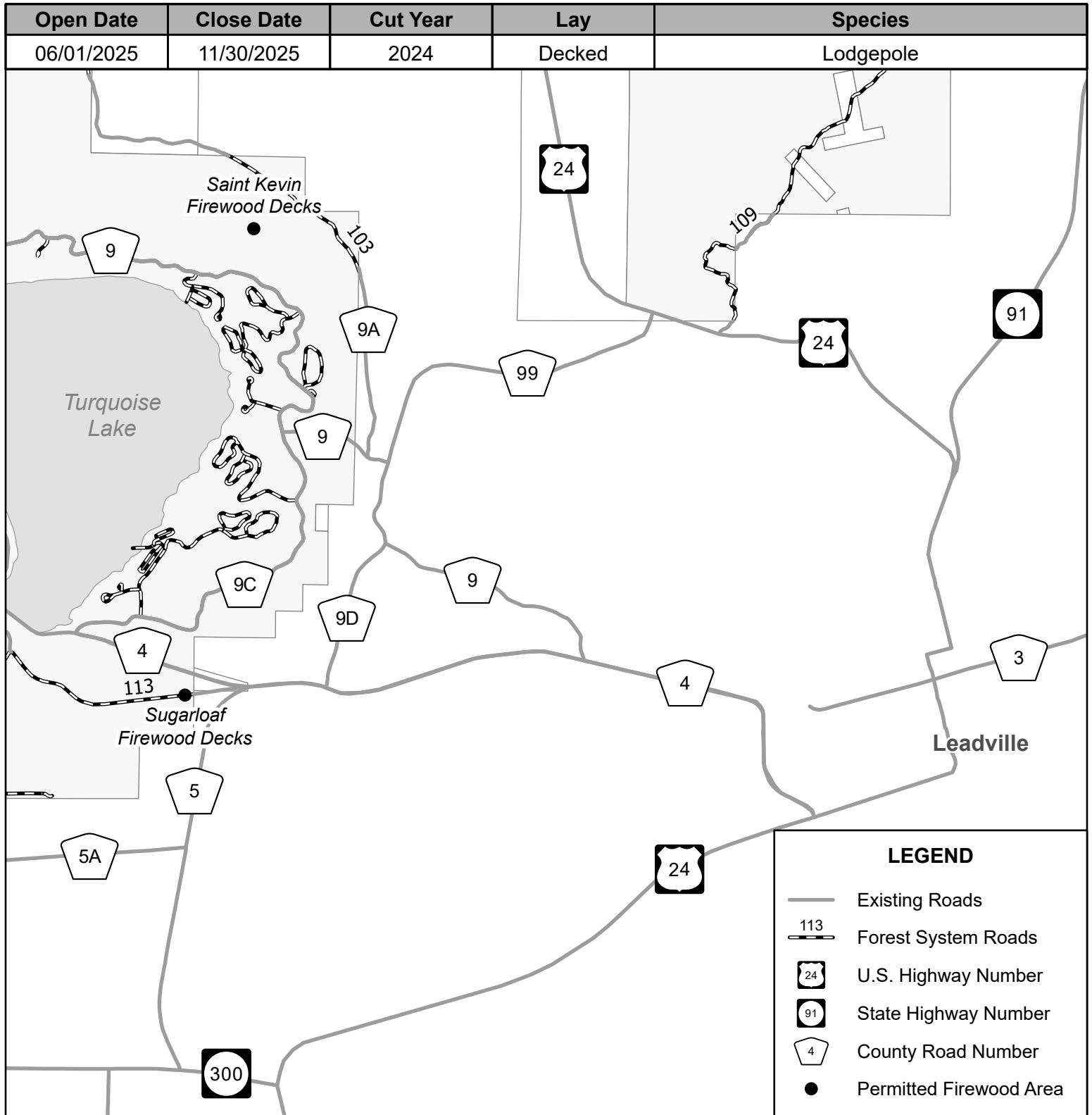


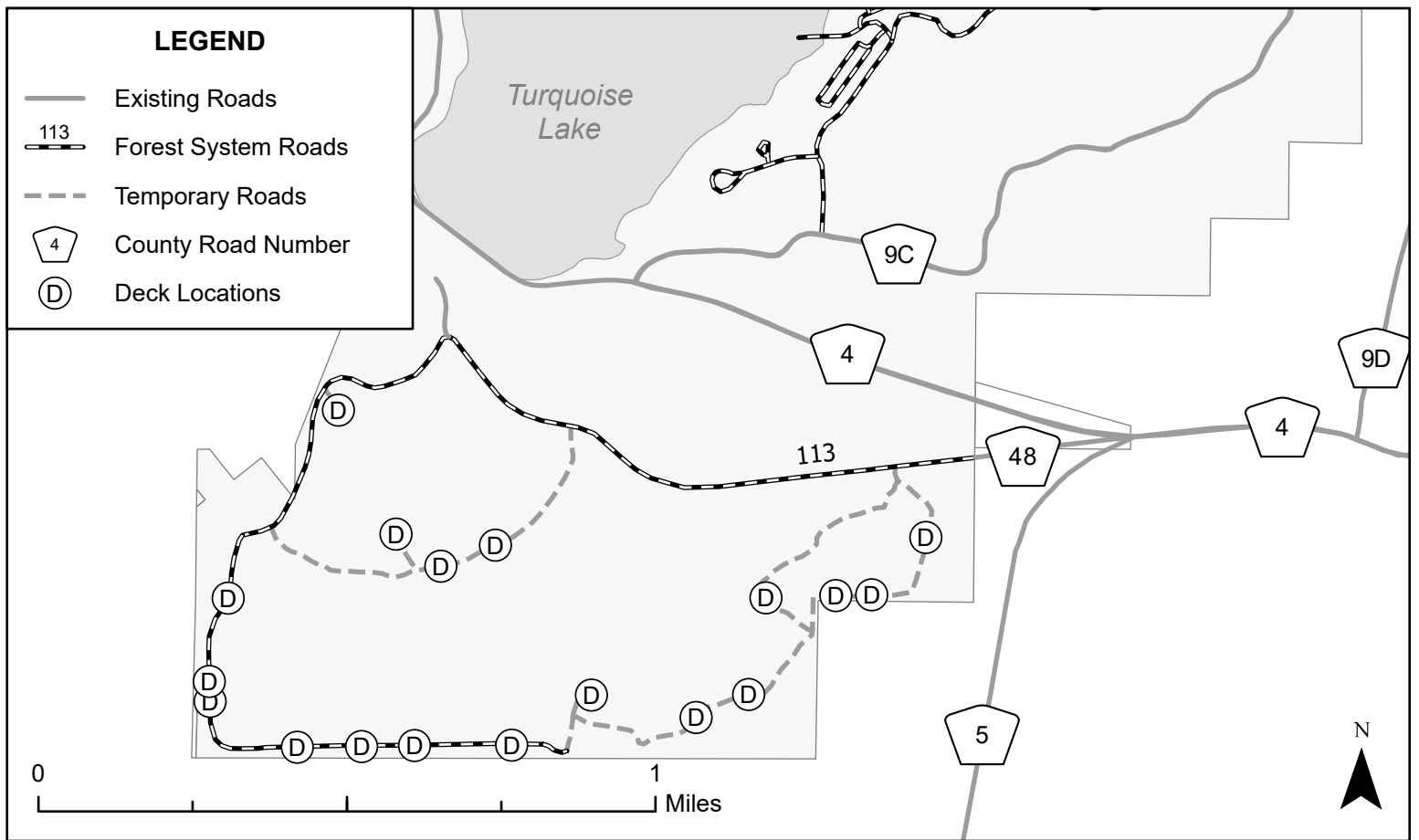
# Sugarloaf Firewood Decks

San Isabel National Forest, Leadville Ranger District, 2025

### **DESCRIPTION**

The area contain several scattered firewood decks along Forest System Road 113. There are also firewood decks located along temporary roads heading off Forest System Road 113. Temporary roads are marked with black/pink striped flagging. Not all deck locations may be open at the same time.

### **DIRECTION**

From Leadville head south on Harrison Ave toward W 6th Street, then turn right onto W 6th Street. Travel 0.8 mile on W 6th Street then turn right onto County Road 4/McWethy Drive. Keep left at the split to continue on County Road 4. Travel 2.6 miles on County Road 4, then keep straight at the three-way split to get onto County Road 48. Continue on County Road 48 as it transition into Forest System Road 113. Look for signs for further directions. Travel time is approximately 10 minutes.

From Buena Vista, get on US-24 W heading toward Leadville. Travel on US-24 W for 30.2 miles, then turn left onto County Road 300. Travel 0.5 mile on County Road 300, then turn right onto County Road 5. Travel 1.9 miles on County Road 5, then take a sharp left onto Forest System Road 113. Look for signs for further directions. Travel time is approximately 36 minutes.

### **ACCOMPANYING CONDITIONS**

- You are only allowed to remove wood from the existing firewood decks and existing down deadwood. Cutting of any standing trees (dead or alive) is prohibited.
- Please stay on established roads and be cautious of recreation traffic in the area.
