

About

The Hearts Content campground offers 26 campsites, each containing a picnic table, fire ring, and tent pad. Two sites also have lean-to shelters and charcoal grills. Vault toilets and pressurized water are available.

A primitive group camping area, with capacity for up to 50 people, is located on the south side of the campground.

The scenic area and campground are located on Pennsylvania Route 2002, across the road from each other. The closest town is Sheffield, about 13 miles east.

Allegheny National Forest Recreation Area Rules

- Use designated fire rings for all fires. Use only dead and downed trees for firewood.
- Please be considerate of other campers. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m..
- Check out time is 2:00 p.m., camping fees are due within 30 minutes of arrival.
- Maximum stay is 14 days. You must occupy your campsite the first night of stay. Your site cannot be unoccupied for more than 24 hours without permission from camp host.
- A maximum of eight people can occupy each site.

- An extra vehicle fee of \$5 may be charged for additional vehicle parking at campsites in excess of 2 vehicles and 1 wheeled camping unit. To prevent resource damage, please utilize overflow parking and do not park on grass or shoulders.
- Weapons, firearms, and fireworks may NOT be discharged in any developed recreation area.
- Waste material from trailers must be deposited at a dump station. Place other trash in provided receptacles.
- Do not hang lanterns or pound nails into trees; this can cause damage or fires.
- No camping is allowed in picnic areas.
- Pets must be leashed at all times.

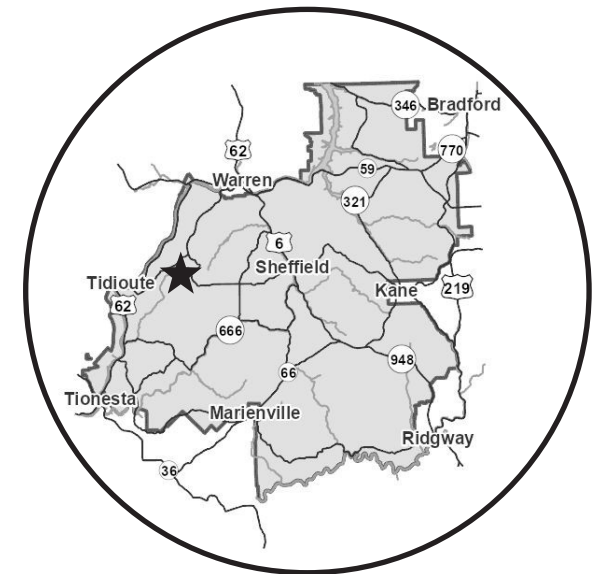

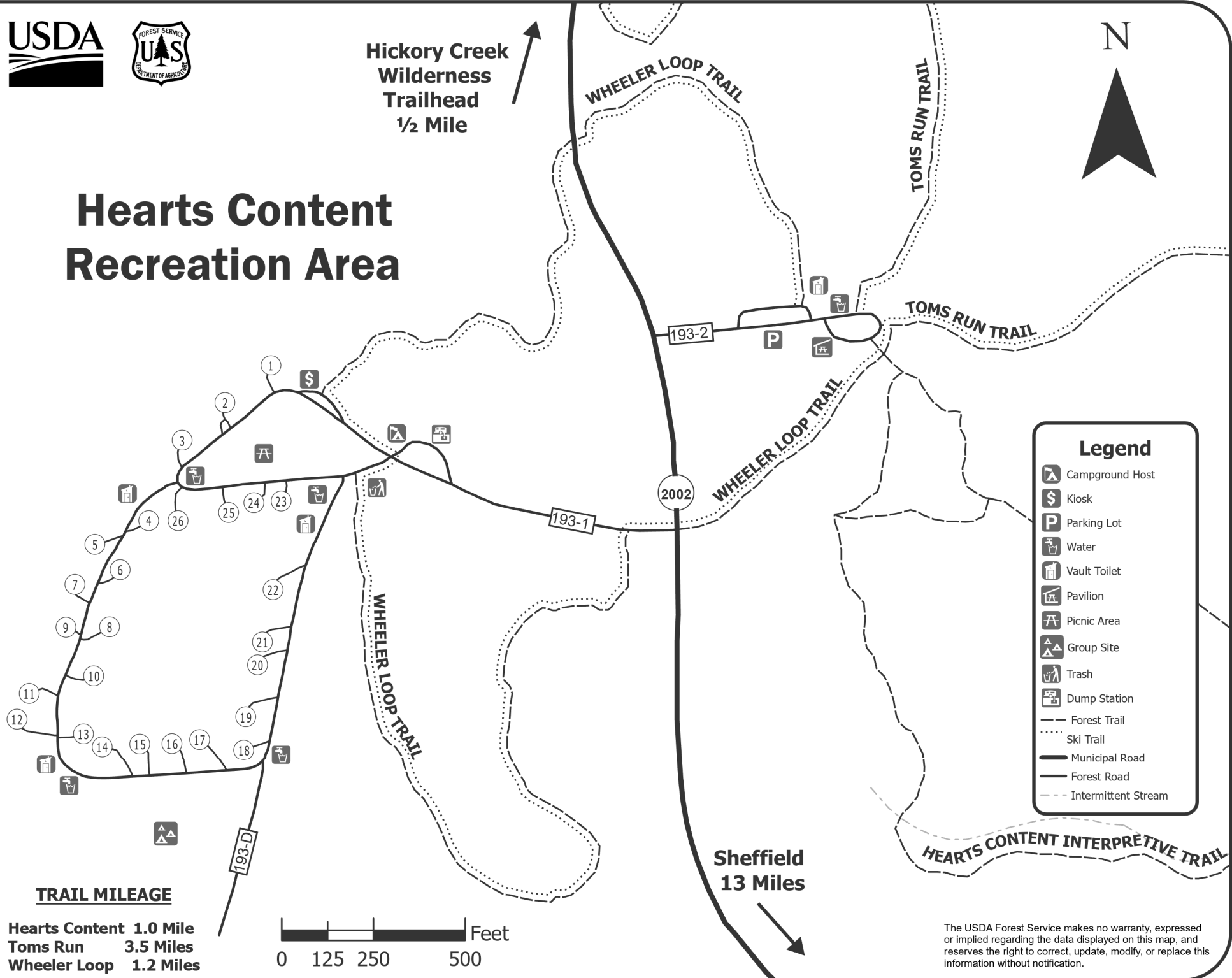
