## West Zone Firewood Information – April 3, 2026

**Free-use Firewood Permits on the Mt. Hood National Forest are free of charge for personal use through November 30, 2026.**

- Mt. Hood National Forest permits the harvest of six cords per household each year for personal use.
- Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.6 (F), firewood obtained under this free use authorization may not be sold or exchanged. Please visit our website or call to inquire about the \$10/cord commercial firewood permit.
- Bring your signed permit, load tags, map, and information sheet with you when gathering firewood.
- Firewood Permits are not valid on roads that are shown as “closed” on the Motor Vehicle Use Map.
- Pack it in, pack it out! Scatter organic debris from woodcutting, pack out litter, do not cause damage.

**Westside Cutting Area has opened for woodcutting along roads currently open to motorized vehicle use.** Excluding areas under seasonal closure for elk and deer calving/fawning season: Forest Roads 4621 (opens 6/30), 6321 (opens 7/31), and 4672-260 spur (opens 7/31).

**Memaloose Weigh Station Firewood Decks are open!** Hwy 224, MP 33.5 as indicated by green “woodcutting area” signs. Please avoid habitat decks with yellow signs indicating “No Firewood Cutting” on the North end and watch out for log trucks delivering more wood midweek.

**No woodcutting within active timber sale areas. Please watch out for equipment and log trucks on these roads:**

- **Summer Home Cabin Owner Permittees:**  
Visit Zigzag District Office with your cabin and lot number for annual permit, tags and authorization to remove fuelwood from hazard trees felled as part of improvements to ingress and egress along summer home roads.
