

# Copper River Trail



**Rating - Easy**  
**1.2 Miles**

## **COPPER RIVER TRAIL**

**Location:** Copper River Highway mile 48 at Million Dollar Bridge Information area.

**Elevation:** 200 ft (61 m)

**Length:** .6 miles (1 km)

**Recommended Season:** Summer, Fall

**USGS Map(s):** CORDOVA (C2 & 3)

**Difficulty:** Easy

**Time:** 1 hour (round trip)

**Use:** Heavy

This trail follows an old road along the Copper River where excellent views of the glacier can be seen at many sections. The hiker first enters thick vegetation, then parallels the river until reaching the Childs Glacier Recreation Area. This recreation area includes: 4 picnic sites (2 covered), 5 tent sites, restrooms, bear proof trashcans, parking areas, and an accessible viewing platform with information panels. There are excellent bird watching opportunities in early summer.
