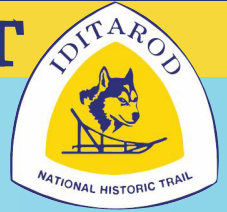

THE IDITAROD NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL (INHT)  
SOUTHERN TREK PROJECT CONNECTS THE  
COMMUNITIES OF SEWARD AND GIRDWOOD WITH YEAR-ROUND  
OPPORTUNITIES

Paralleling the historic INHT  
south of Anchorage, it weaves through the  
Chugach National Forest.

The Southern Trek is 75% complete.

Only three significant gaps remain:  
Moose Pass, Turnagain Pass, and Twentymile Valley.

Plans are completed, construction  
will continue as funds become  
available.
