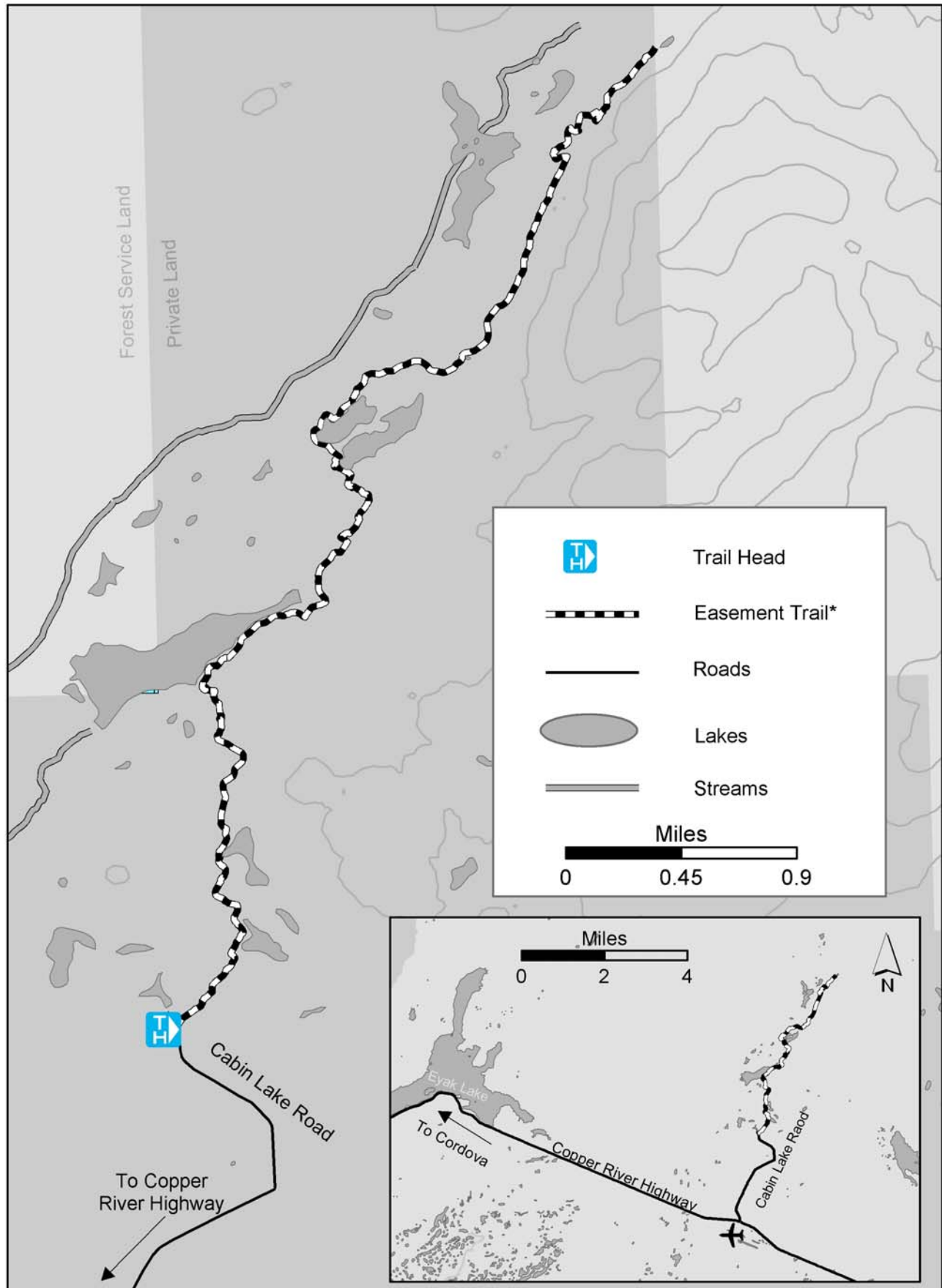


# Lake Elsner Trail



**Rating - Difficult**  
**6.0 Miles**

\*17 (b) easements provide access to public lands, granted through ANCSA part 17(b), through privately owned lands of the Alaska Native Corporations. Please respect private property rights by staying on the trails and do not trespass. Activities in this area i.e. berry picking, picnicking, temporary camping, etc. require a permit from the Eyak Corporation (P# 424-7161).

## **LAKE ELSNER TRAIL**

**Location:** Via Copper River Highway to mile 12.1. Turn north on Cabin Lake Road. Follow main road 2.8 miles to the end.

**Elevation:** 200 ft - 300 ft (61 m - 91 m)

**Length:** 6.0 miles (9.7 km)

**Recommended Season:** Summer, Fall

**Difficulty:** Difficult

**USGS Map(s):** CORDOVA (C-4)

**Time:** 9 hours (round trip)

**Use:** Light

This lightly sloping trail parallels the east side of the Scott Valley and passes the shores of several small and large lakes. The trail passes through previously logged areas with little maintenance work from beginning to end. The entire trail is a "17(b)" easement.\*
