General Regulations:

- Vehicles must stay within 150 feet of a road
- No cutting of material >5 inches diameter in riparian areas
- Removal of dead standing and dead down material only
- No cutting allowed in the following areas:
 - o Campgrounds and administrative sites
 - o Non-Forest Service Land
 - o Timber Sale Areas (identified by paint-banded trees)
 - o Designated Wilderness Areas
 - o Within 200 feet of Logan Canyon Scenic Byway - US 89
