The Monongahela National Forest is soliciting proposals from interested parties for a campground concession special use permit (SUP) to provide high-quality public service in the operation and maintenance of government-owned recreation facilities. The Forest intends for the successful applicant to be awarded the SUP in early 2026. The three-year average gross revenue for this offer is \$128,310.
