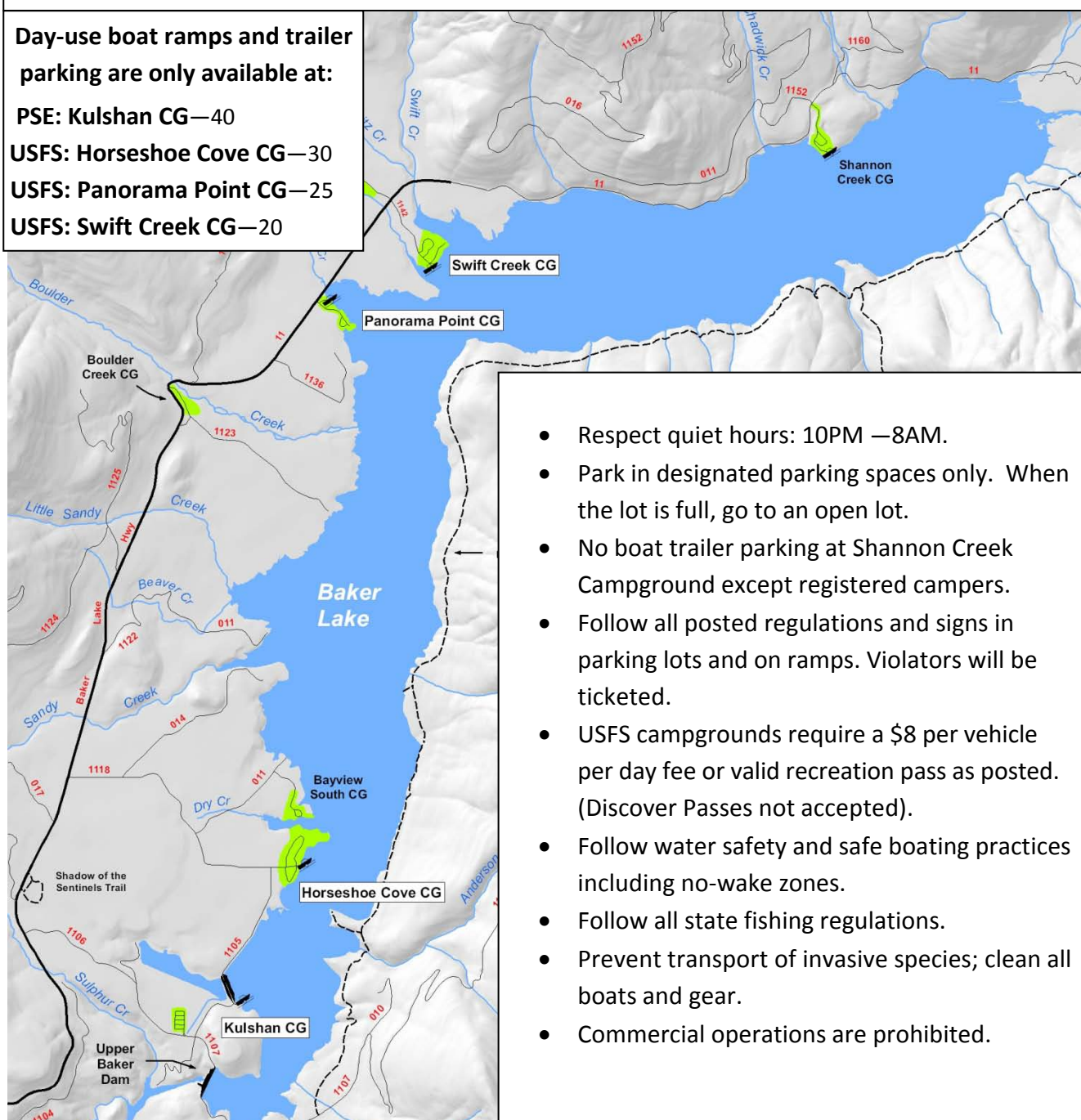
**Day-use boat ramps and trailer parking are only available at:**

**PSE: Kulshan CG—40**

**USFS: Horseshoe Cove CG—30**

**USFS: Panorama Point CG—25**

**USFS: Swift Creek CG—20**



- Respect quiet hours: 10PM —8AM.
- Park in designated parking spaces only. When the lot is full, go to an open lot.
- No boat trailer parking at Shannon Creek Campground except registered campers.
- Follow all posted regulations and signs in parking lots and on ramps. Violators will be ticketed.
- USFS campgrounds require a \$8 per vehicle per day fee or valid recreation pass as posted. (Discover Passes not accepted).
- Follow water safety and safe boating practices including no-wake zones.
- Follow all state fishing regulations.
- Prevent transport of invasive species; clean all boats and gear.
- Commercial operations are prohibited.
