Location: The Island Creek fire is located 14 air miles north of Elk City, ID on the Moose Creek Ranger District.

Start Date: July 31, 2025 **Cause:** Lightning **Size:** 14,027 Acres

Containment: 5% **Total Personnel:** 277

KEY MESSAGE:

Firefighters are continuing structure protection efforts in the Selway River corridor. Hot and dry weather continues until Friday. Air resources continue to be utilized to support the incident. An expanded closure order went into effect Friday, August 29, 2025, as described under closures and special messages below. Mail and package delivery services will continue for residents.

CURRENT STATUS:

Yesterday, fire personnel continued to work in the area west of Gedney Creek and north of the Selway River confluence to prevent further fire spread to the west. Crews are assessing and felling hazard trees along the Selway River corridor to ensure firefighter and public safety. Structure protection resources collected information in the Selway River corridor. They prepared a structure protection plan and will begin implementation measures today. A night shift presence will remain in the Selway River corridor for the next couple of nights. Crews and heavy equipment continue to make good progress on the shaded fuel breaks along the 464 and 443 roads.

WEATHER AND FIRE BEHAVIOR

The heat advisory has been extended through tonight until 10:00pm due to continued hot and dry weather conditions. A high-pressure weather system will move through the area on Thursday evening which may produce winds coming out of the east. Fire activity is expected to increase until lower temperatures and chances of precipitation move into the region on Friday. Lower temperatures and a slight chance of precipitation over the weekend may lead to a slow decrease in fire behavior.

CLOSURES AND SPECIAL MESSAGES:

As hunters and recreationists visit the Forest for fall hunting seasons and other activities, they should be aware of the expanded closure order. It includes parts of the forest bounded by the Coolwater Road, the Falls Point and American River Road, NFSR 464, NFSR 1129, NFSR 1119, NFSR 223, the Eagle Mountain Trail (#206), the Coves Lake Trail (#3), the Big Rock Trail (#693), the Three Links Trail (#495), the Mink Peak Trail (#438), and the High Line Ridge Trail (#626).
