FOREST SERVICE ROAD 25 ROAD CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands, roads and trails described in this Order and depicted on Exhibit A, within and/or administered by the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Cowlitz Valley Ranger District. This Order is effective September 22, 2025, through December 31, 2025.

PROHIBITION:

Being on the road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e).

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to protect public health and safety to allow for safe and efficient construction operations on and near Huffaker Bridge, which is also located on FSR 25 at milepost 7.66.

ROAD CLOSURE:

Travel is prohibited on the following National Forest System Roads (FSR) as described below and shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

- FSR 25 from the junction of FSR 2508 to the junction of FSR 26.

EXEMPTIONS:

1. Any Federal, State, or County officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation Order), specifically exempting them from this order.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3551, 3559, 3571, and 3581).
