Subject: Fuelwood Cutting in Trout Creek Campground

The McCloud Ranger District is permitting fuelwood cutting in the Trout Creek Campground.

The Fuelwood Cutting Map shows location and area for allowing fuelwood cutting. Fuelwood cutting is allowed within the Trout Creek administration site, as per Fuelwood Cutting Map. A valid Shasta Trinity National Forest Fuelwood Cutting Permit is required. For more information visit the Web Site:

- Firewood permits are available at \$2/cord with a minimum purchase of \$20 and a 12-cord limit per household per calendar year.
- Purchasers must contact their local ranger station regarding purchasing a permit.
- Woodcutters are **required to hold a permit** and must follow the associated regulations within that permit and the Shasta-Trinity National Forest Fuelwood Cutting Map.
- **As a reminder:** it is the responsibility of the permit holder to check and be aware of the daily firewood cutting restrictions in effect.
 - All firewood-cutting rules remain in place.
 - Woodcutting requirements may vary substantially so please call your local ranger district office to see if there are any specific local restrictions or requirements.

Additional conditions to follow for fuelwood cutting in Trout Creek Campground include:

- No cutting of any standing tree without Forest Service permission.
- Fuelwood cutting down logs is allowed.
- Fuelwood cutting of covered piles is **not allowed**.
- Fuelwood cutting is prohibited in the vicinity of camp sites if occupied.
- Fuelwood cutting is allowed within 300 feet of Trout Creek.
- Cut rounds are approved to remove.
