We provide training and an experienced guide for each trip. Volunteers do not need to be experts.

Requirements:

- An interest in learning and sharing knowledge.
- Able to hike up to 4-miles over hilly terrain in adverse weather.
- Transportation to and from Glacier Public Service Center (10091 Mt. Baker Highway, Glacier, Washington 98244).
- Available for training on January 25 or 28 and at least one Sunday trip late-February - March.
- Condition appropriate outerwear including goggles. Snowshoes and poles provided.
