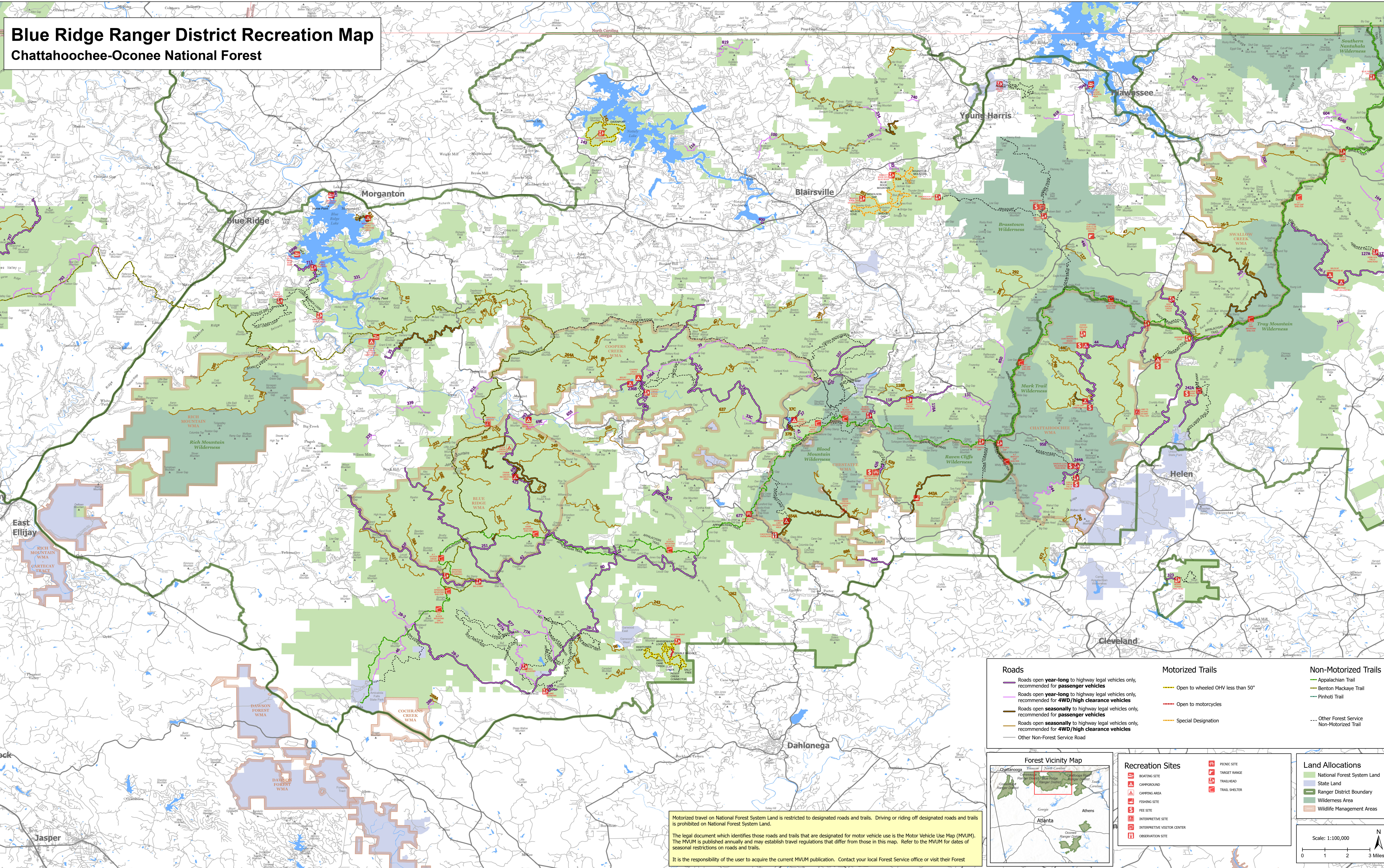


Blue Ridge Ranger District Recreation Map

Motorized travel on National Forest System Land is restricted to designated roads and trails. Driving or riding off designated roads and trails is prohibited on National Forest System Land.

The legal document which identifies those roads and trails that are designated for motor vehicle use is the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM). The MVUM is published annually and may establish travel regulations that differ from those in this map. Refer to the MVUM for dates of seasonal restrictions on roads and trails.

It is the responsibility of the user to acquire the current MVUM publication. Contact your local Forest Service office or visit their Forest
