Ground Operations – For example, road and trail maintenance; facility operations such as painting, cleaning restrooms, re-roofing, and maintaining kiosks; regulatory and directional trail signs, and repaving existing parking lots.

Law Enforcement — For example, enforcement of federal laws, enforcement of OHV state laws, regulations for public safety, protection of natural and cultural resources, emergency response to OHV accidents, and providing OHV information at community events.

Restoration — For example, repair of environmental damage caused by illegal off-highway vehicle use.

Development: — For example, development of new trails or restroom construction.

Acquisition: For example, securing land for future OHV opportunities.
