### 5/5/2026 Winter travel routes conditions

These roads and gates have been opened due to historically low snowpack. While these roads are snow-free there may be snowdrifts remaining on some side roads and not all routes have been cleared of downed trees. We have received some moisture recently causing some roads to become muddy. Please avoid all muddy roads.

**County Road 8 (North Fork):** This road is now open from Meeker, CO to Yampa, CO. **County Road 10 (South Fork):** This road is open all the way to the South Fork Campground and can be traveled by passenger cars. The campground opens May 13<sup>th</sup>.

**County Road 12 and Forest Service Road 222 (Marvine Road):** This road is open and available to access the Marvine area trailheads. The campgrounds do not open for public use until May 13<sup>th</sup>.

**FSR 245 (Buford-New Castle Road):** This road is open from Buford to New Castle, CO.
