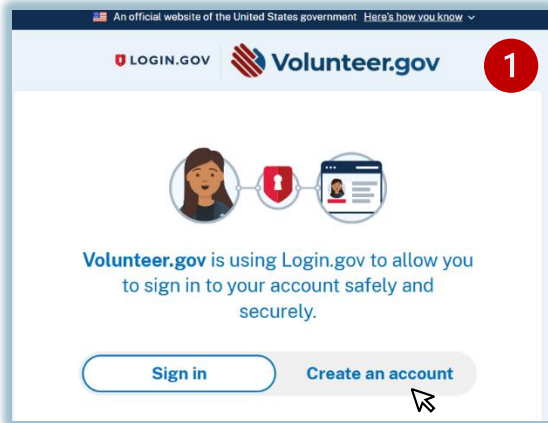
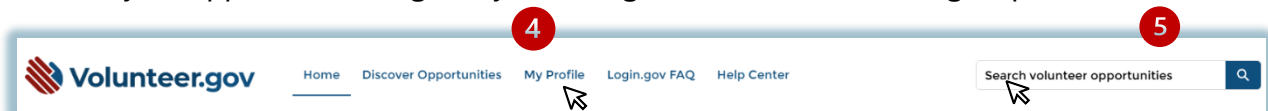


Once your Login.gov account is set up, ¹ go to Volunteer.gov and sign in. From there, you'll be prompted to either access your established account or it is your "first time logging in to Volunteer.gov" ² if choosing first time, you will be prompted to initiate your profile details. ³ Once into the main database click the "My Profile" tab to more thoroughly fill out your profile. ⁴ This information helps autofill your applications and is used to complete the required Volunteer Service Agreement (OF301a) for each opportunity.

When your profile is ready, you can search ⁵ for volunteer openings with Nebraska National Forests and Grasslands by using the search bar on Volunteer.gov. When you find a project you're interested in, simply select "Apply Now." A Forest Service staff member will review your application and guide you through the online onboarding steps.
