

About

The Buckaloons campground offers 58 campsites, two double sites, and one group site. Each site contains a picnic table, fire ring, and tent site. Several sites also have charcoal grates.

Amenities include showers, flush toilets, a pressurized water system, and a dump station. Electrical hookups are available on most sites. The campground also has a pavilion, picnic area, basketball court, and a concrete boat launch accessing the Allegheny Wild and Scenic River.

The campground is located on National Forge Road in Irvine, about 8 miles west of Warren.

Allegheny National Forest Recreation Area Rules

- Use designated fire rings for all fires. Use only dead and downed trees for firewood.
- Please be considerate of other campers. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Check out time is 2:00 p.m., camping fees are due within 30 minutes of arrival.
- Maximum stay is 14 days. You must occupy your campsite the first night of stay. Your site cannot be unoccupied for more than 24 hours without permission from camp host.

- A maximum of eight people can occupy each site.
- An extra vehicle fee of \$5 may be charged for additional vehicle parking at campsites in excess of 2 vehicles and 1 wheeled camping unit. To prevent resource damage, please utilize overflow parking and do not park on grass or shoulders.
- Weapons, firearms, and fireworks may NOT be discharged in any developed recreation area.
- Waste material from trailers must be deposited at a dump station. Place other trash in provided receptacles.
- Do not hang lanterns or pound nails into trees; this can cause damage or fires.
- No camping is allowed in picnic areas.
- Pets must be leashed at all times.

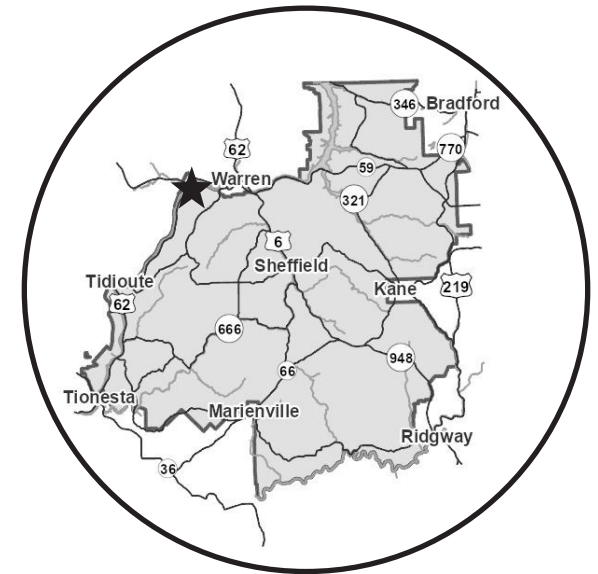

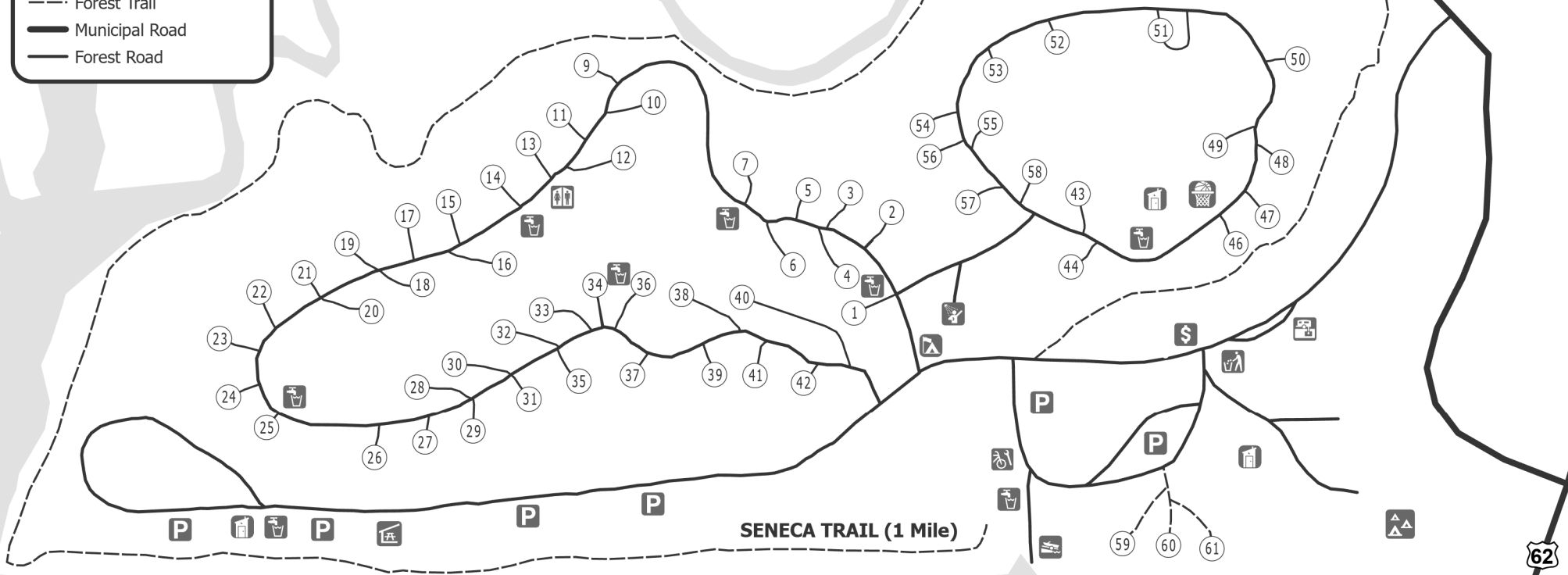
