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# Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest Outfitter and Guide Request for Information

## Questions and Answers

### 1. If I/we already have a priority use SUP, do we need to respond?

If you anticipate or would like to be considered for additional uses or days over the next 10 years, it is recommended that you respond.

### 2. If I/we already have a temporary use SUP, do we need to respond?

If you are interested in becoming a priority use permit holder with location and service days identified, it is recommended that you respond.

### 3. If I/we already have a priority use SUP, will this change anything with our existing permitted use?

This will not change any existing authorized permits. It is an opportunity to identify additional interest for your current or other O&G opportunities. For example:

- If you have a permit for the Logan RD and you are interested in providing services in another portion of the forest, this would be an opportunity to let us know.
- If you are interested in expanding and could use additional user days, this is an opportunity to let us know.

### 4. If I/we are interested in applying for a seasonal (just summer/fall) in the future, do I/we need to fill this out? Or is this JUST for year-round?

Any information on your interest to be an outfitter and guide on the Forest would assist us in understanding the demand related to the outfitter and guide opportunity, season, and location.

### 5. If we are already a permit holder we do not have to participate, correct?

If you are interested in becoming a priority use permit holder with location and service days identified, it is recommended that you respond.

### 6. Will the Forest Service take into consideration and factor in the amount of permits already issued in the area?

Yes, the Forest will take into consideration currently issued Priority Use (multi-year) Special Use permits. For temporary permit holders, it's strongly recommended that you respond to the RFI if you are interested in additional opportunities, since historic permits had limited user days, and the assumption is that permit holders would like additional opportunities.

### 7. I have been issued temporary permits since 2019. I would like to get a permit before it's last minute.

This RFI is not a formal application process but is intended to determine the level of interest and identify next steps for issuing priority use outfitter guide SUPs.
