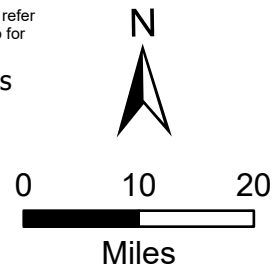


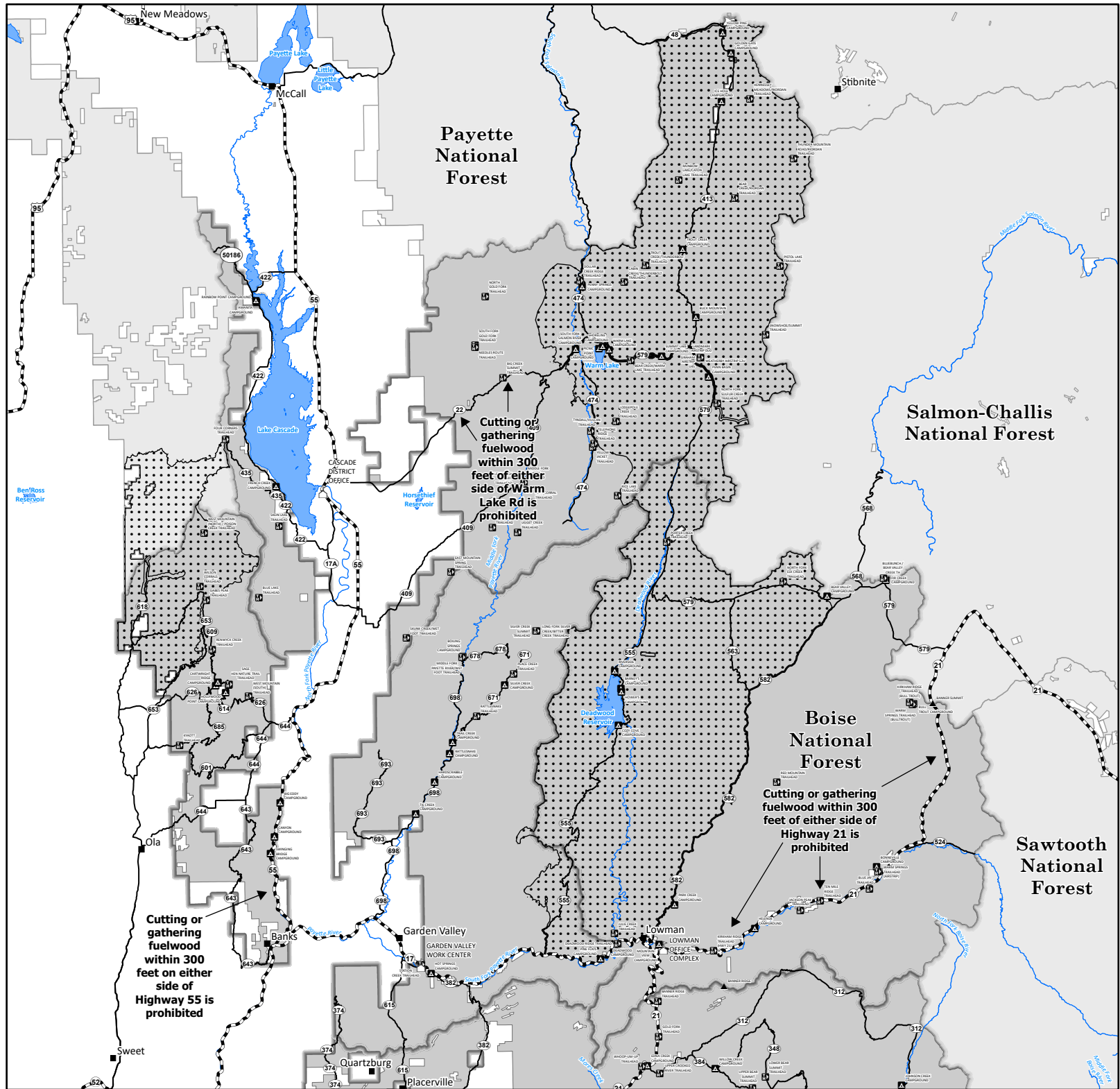

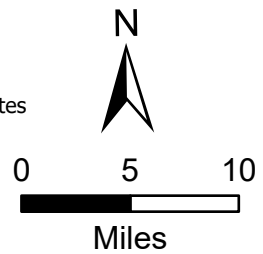
2026 Firewood Permit Map - North Zone

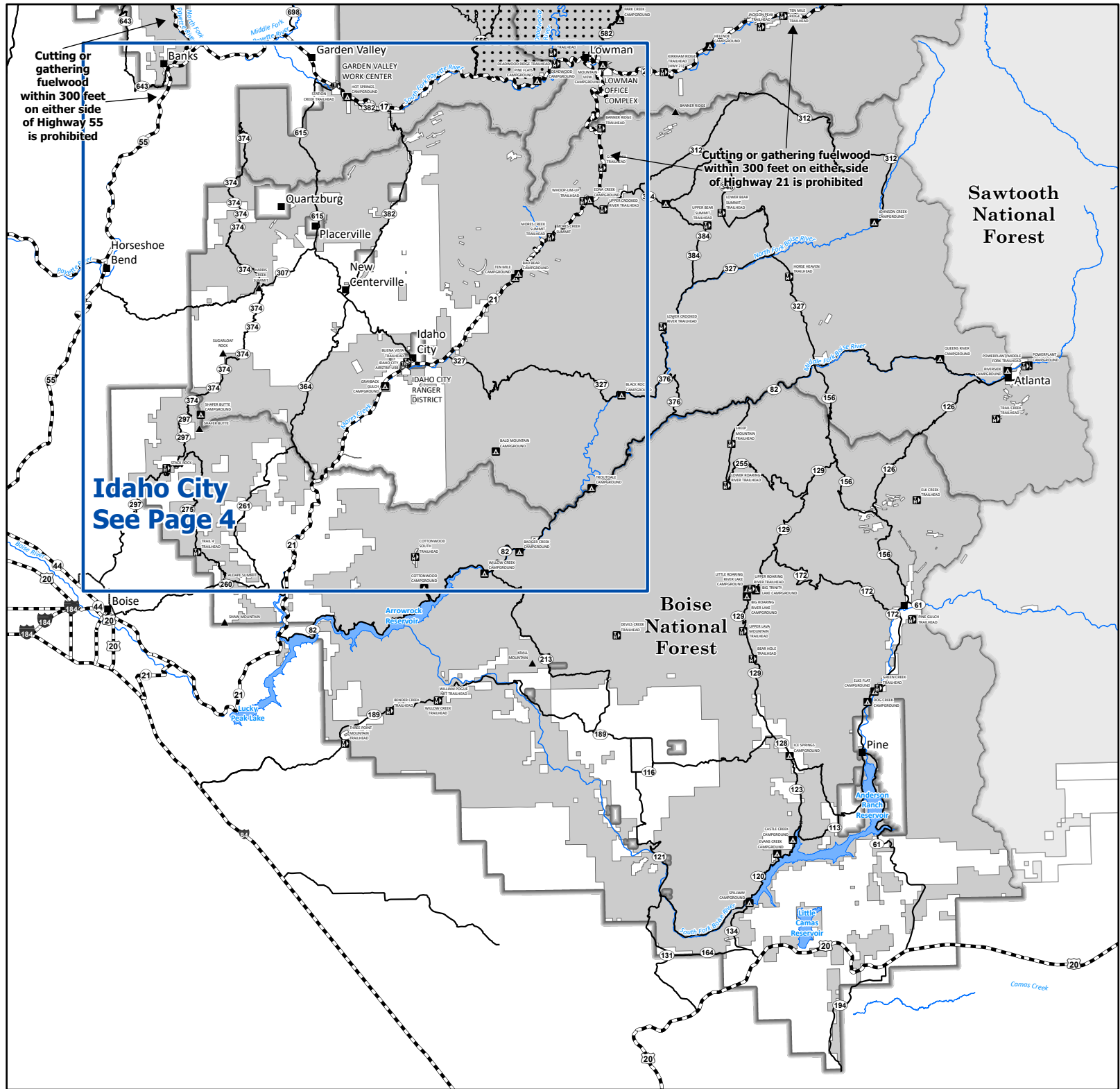

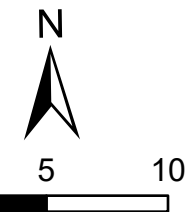
