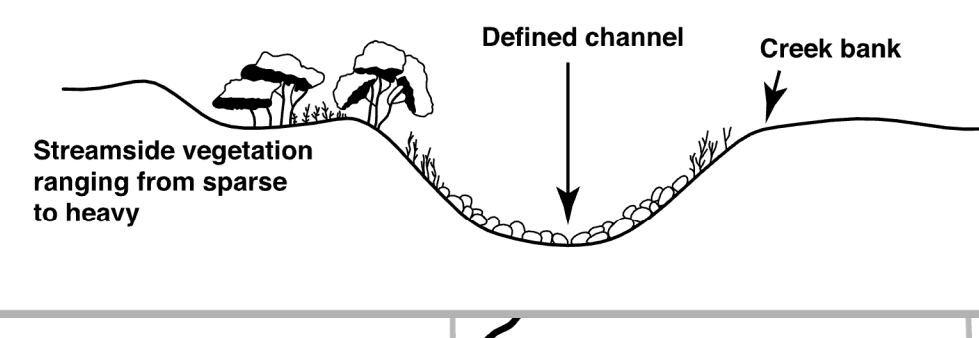


The Boise-Payette National Forests fuelwood permit is **NOT** valid for cutting in the Cape Horn area on the Salmon-Challis NF.

RIPARIAN CONSERVATION AREAS
 RCA (See additional information on page 3 of the fuelwood brochure.)

- Perennial Streams**
 NO fuelwood cutting within 300 feet either side of stream.
 Not all are shown on map.
- Lakes, Reservoirs, Swamps & Marshes**
 No fuelwood cutting 150 feet from edges.
 Not all are shown on map.
- Intermittent Streams**
 Water runs intermittently throughout the year & may become a dry stream channel.
 No fuelwood cutting within 150 feet either side of stream channel whether actively running water or not.



When cutting fuelwood on the SAWTOOTH NATIONAL FOREST refer to the SAWTOOTH NF Personal Use Firewood Map for regulations and locations.

You must have a SAWTOOTH NF map/brochure with you in order to comply with permit requirements on the SAWTOOTH NF.

Do NOT CUT dead Ponderosa Pine (PP) larger than 24" in diameter on the Sawtooth NF.

Noxious weeds are spread onto National Forest lands when seeds are carried in and take root.

Wash your vehicles and equipment inside and out before your next trip.

Always Clean, Keep it Pristine!

Free use area limited to 300 feet either side of the road and only on National Forest lands. All RCA and other restrictions apply in free use areas. A free use permit is required.

Cutting or gathering fuelwood within 300 feet on either side of the following roads is prohibited:

- State Highway 21, from Grimes Creek northeast to Banner Summit
- State Highway 55, within the Boise National Forest boundary
- US Highway 95
- Federal Highway 22, also known as the Warm Lake Highway

- National Forest Lands Open to Fuelwood Cutting
- National Forest and Non-National Forest Lands - CLOSED to Fuelwood Cutting
- National Forest Lands - Free Use - Permit Required - See local Ranger District Office
- ▬ Ranger District Boundaries
- ▬ Sawtooth and Salmon-Challis National Forests Boundaries
- Waterbody
- No Cutting Within 300 ft of the Road
- ▬ River/ Perennial Stream
