Welcome to the White Mountain National Forest, a fascinating place to visit in any season.

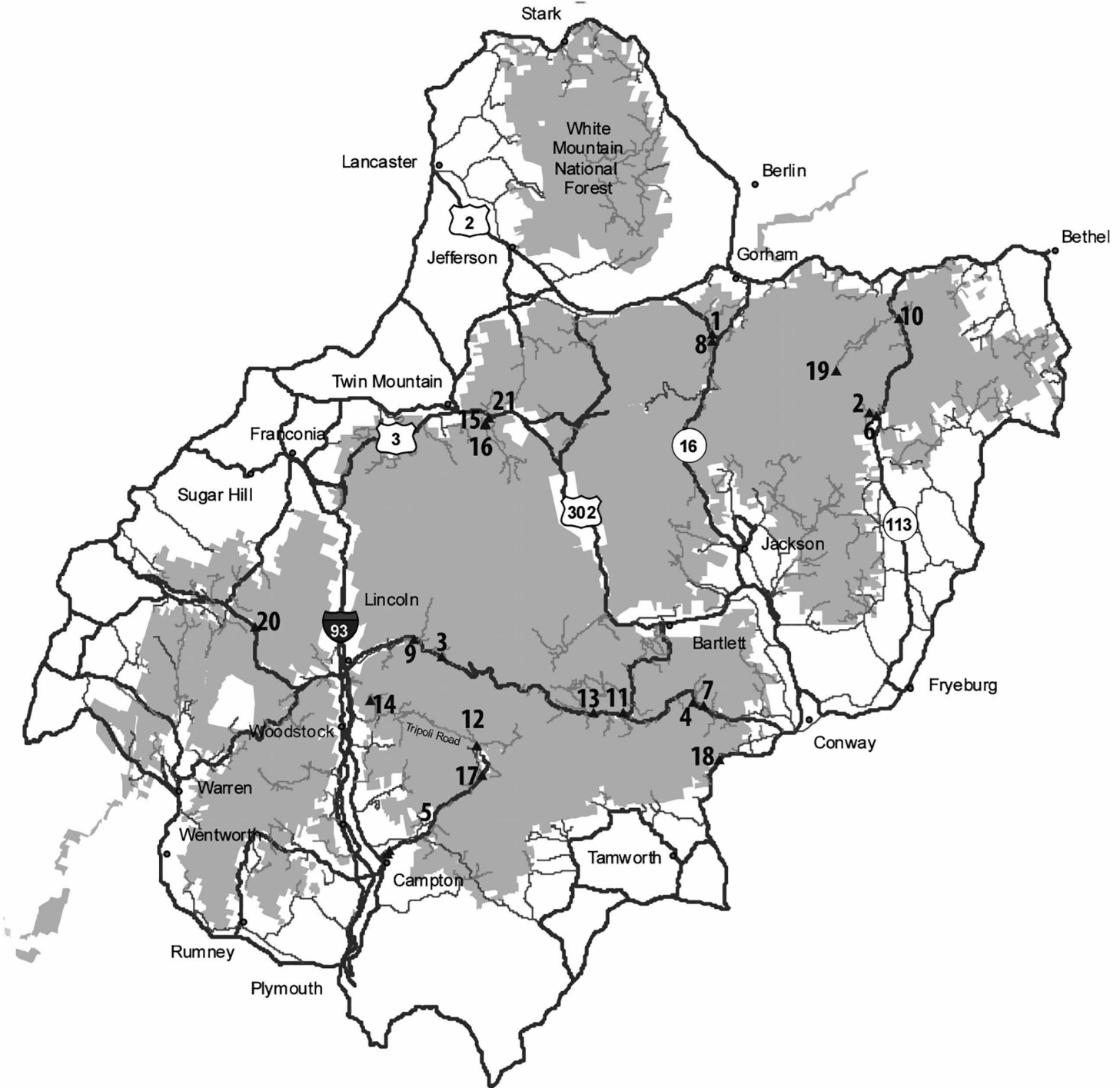
Developed campgrounds offer a variety of camping experiences for families and groups of different sizes.

CAMPGROUND FEES AND RESERVATIONS

Excluding group sites, campground fees range from \$24 to \$30 per night, and include two motor vehicles. Extra vehicles may be allowed if space permits. A fee of \$6 is charged for each additional vehicle. A maximum of eight people are allowed per site. Maximum RV length varies by campsite. Check www.recreation.gov for details.

2 dogs are permitted per site but must be leashed and attended to. Check in is 2:00pm and check out is 12:00pm. Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am.

Some sites are first come first served and some may be reserved at www.recreation.gov or by phone (877-444-6777/TTY:877-833-6777) and must be made at least 4 days before date of arrival. There is a 2 night weekend minimum and 3 night holiday minimum for reservations.

Holders of an Interagency Senior, Interagency Access, Golden Age, or Golden Access pass receive a 50% discount on single site camping fees (does not apply to utility hookups or group sites (Osceola Vista and Barnes Field in the summer) The pass holder must be one of the campers.
